Jak vážně byla čínská ekonomika zasažena Covid-19?

Údaje naznačují, že škody byly velmi vážné. Například **v roce 2019 činil růst HDP Číny 5,95 procenta. Ale v roce 2020 růst HDP klesl na 2,24 procenta, což je téměř 4procentní spirála smrti, kterou lze zcela připsat Covid-19.** V roce 2021 se růst čínského HDP odrazil na 8,45 procenta, ale pak v roce 2022 prudce klesl na žalostných 2,9 procenta. Bezprostřední příčinou klesajícího růstu čínského HDP byl opět Covid.

Stojí za zmínku, že růst čínského HDP je od roku 1990 v průměru přes 9 procent. To jsou 3 desetiletí meteorického růstu, který byl náhle vykolejen kvůli relativně mírné virové infekci. Jak se to stane? Stalo se to proto, že média, farmaceutické společnosti, západní vlády a odborníci na veřejné zdraví značně zveličovali smrtící účinek Covidu, což vedlo k omezením, která ničí ekonomiku. To platilo zejména v případě Číny, která uzavřela celá města a desítky milionů lidí v boji s patogenem, který zabil méně než 0,5 procenta lidí, které infikoval.

Redaktor Ron Unz věří, že Covid-19 byla biologická zbraň vytvořená v USA, která byla použita při útoku na Čínu na konci roku 2019.

Podle Unze Covid nepochází z luskounů nebo netopýrů, ale je to **biologická zbraň vytvořená v laboratoři. který byl navržen tak, aby sabotoval čínskou ekonomiku.** Jak Unz dospěl ke svým závěrům, vysvětlíme dále v článku, ale zatím vycházíme z předpokladu, že má pravdu a že škody, které byly způsobeny čínské ekonomice, byly záměrným válečným aktem. Takto vypadá katastrofa v reálném čase. Jak vám řekne každý ekonom, když spotřebitelská důvěra oslabuje, lidé omezují své výdaje, což způsobuje pokles ekonomické aktivity, což má za následek pomalejší růst. To platí zejména tehdy, když se média zapojují do nepřetržitého šíření strachu ve snaze přesvědčit masu, že všichni zemřou na nějaký vykonstruovaný mor, který se šíří krajinou. To je přesně ten typ propagandy, který vytváří graf, jako je ten výše. Je to ilustrace psychologické války, která byla vedena proti čínskému lidu.

Stejné pravidlo lze aplikovat na průmyslovou výrobu a maloobchodní tržby, které také zaznamenaly prudký pokles kvůli hybridnímu útoku Washingtonu. Podívej se:

Pak je tu sektor nemovitostí, který byl během pandemie také zablokován. Jak můžete vidět, ceny a prodeje prudce klesly a způsobily další snížení spotřebitelských výdajů. Když ceny bydlení klesnou, majitelé domů se cítí méně bohatí a snižují své výdaje. Všude je to stejné. Všechno tento vývoj je přirozeně pro ekonomiku velmi špatný.

Samozřejmě byly ovlivněny i další části ekonomiky, ale – mějte na paměti – ekonomické škody jsou jen částí příběhu. Covid také způsobil obrovskou psychickou újmu a politickou nestabilitu, které západní média téměř zcela ignorovaly. Podívejte se na tento klip z článku v Guardianu:

Když vláda opustí „nulový Covid“, může to trvat desetiletí, než se obyčejní Číňané vzpamatují – a mnozí si nejsou jisti, že to stálo za to... **Poté, co Čína náhle ustoupila od svých omezení s nulovým výskytem Covidu, mnoho obyčejných Číňanů se snaží vyrovnat se s duševním traumatem z tří let častého zavírání a požadují odpovědi za vysokou cenu, kterou zaplatili.**

V pátek byl jedním z hlavních sdílených příspěvků na Sina Weibo – čínské platformě Titter-like – článek citující **lékařské odborníky, kteří tvrdili, že deprese, úzkost a posttraumatická stresová porucha, kterými trpí populace, bude pravděpodobně trvat 10 až 20 let, než se zotaví. od .**

Lu Lin, člen Čínské akademie věd, v pátek na fóru řekl, že **až 20 % zdravotníků, pacientů a členů veřejnosti může trpět posttraumatickou stresovou poruchou a téměř jedna třetina z nich v domácí karanténě vykazovali příznaky deprese, úzkosti a nespavosti.** Další odborníci volali po pohotovostních službách na podporu duševního zdraví komunity.

"Co je ještě děsivější než koronavirus, je strach a duševní úzkost," uvedl jeden komentář Weibo...

Xiao Han, liberální právní akademik, tweetoval: „Proto jsme podpořili všechna ta šílená zablokování, zastavení výroby a podnikání [které vyústily v] bankroty, sebevraždy a požáry?... [Oni] ignorují humanitární katastrofy, protože tak- zvané oběť pro větší dobro. Mohou se nyní oběti ptát: ‚Za co?‘“ ...‘ K čemu to bylo?‘: mentální daň za tři roky Číny v karanténě Covid , Guardian

Zde je více z výzkumného dokumentu v NIH o psychologickém dopadu pandemie COVID-19 na čínskou populaci:

Stručně řečeno, **epidemie COVID-19 všeobecně způsobila PTSD u běžné čínské populace.** Míra psychické tísně je navíc spojena s věkem, profesí a socioekonomickým postavením. Důvod, proč se ekonomika nezměnila, je ten, že Číňané v roce 2022 čelili spoustě snižování platů a nezaplaceným volnám. Čínský spotřebitel však čelí větším geopolitickým problémům. Důvěra čínských spotřebitelů je nejhorší za 25 let . **Poptávka po úvěrech je slabá.**

Postupné oživení v roce 2023

Rein vrhá světlo na to, jak velkou škodu způsobila čínská politika blokování ekonomice a duševnímu zdraví čínského lidu. Co však nezmiňuje, je to, jak **restrikce „nula Covid“ položily základy pro masivní sociální nepokoje a politickou nestabilitu.** Po 3 kolech dlouhého blokování vypukly po celé zemi protesty, které nakonec donutily vládu změnit svou politiku a zrušit obtížná omezení, která držela lidi jako vězně v jejich vlastních domovech. Demonstrace byly také silným pokáráním čínskému vůdci Si Ťin-pchingovi, který se stal úzce spojen se sadou předpisů volně nazvaných „nulový COVID“ a jejichž cílem bylo udržet počty nakažených koronavirem blízko nule. Čínské úřady tiše shromažďují lidi, kteří protestovali proti pravidlům COVID, NPR

ČKS očividně věřila, že se do protestů zapojily západní zpravodajské agentury, i když zatím neexistují žádné důkazy, které by to podpořily. Na webu Rady pro zahraniční vztahy se však objevil článek, který se zdál být neobvykle zaujatý protesty, zejména pokud se týkaly zranitelnosti čínské vlády. Zde je úryvek z článku:

Tato vlna protestů je zvláštní pro svou přímou kritiku politiky centrální vlády ohledně nulového COVID. ...Za pozornost stojí i nadnárodní mobilizace protestů. Číňané ve velkých městech po celém světě, jako je New York, Londýn, Berlín a Paříž, organizovali vigilie a protesty, aby zvýšili povědomí a projevíli solidaritu s demonstranty v Číně.....

Protesty slouží jako důkaz toho, že navzdory tvrdé cenzuře a tvrdým zásahům mohou Číňané používat kreativní nástroje, aby jejich hlasy byly slyšet... **je také možné, že budoucí protesty v Číně budou vyžadovat širší požadavky na občanská práva.... Pokud budou lidé pokračovat v těchto požadavcích, obvyklá vládní strategie k rozptýlení a rozptýlení by se nakonec mohla stát nedostatečnou k uklidnění veřejných nepokojů .** Skončily čínské pouliční protesty krutou politikou COVID? Rada pro zahraniční vztahy

Předpokládaný návrat 2023
