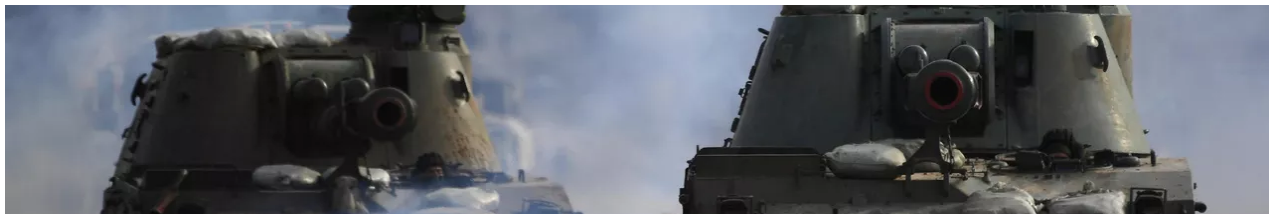


ŽIVÉ AKTUALIZACE: USA zůstávají nezávazné ohledně žádosti o ukrajinský stíhací letoun - vyslanec OBSE

Spojené státy a západní země zvýšily svou vojenskou podporu Ukrajině poté, co Rusko zahájilo speciální vojenskou operaci. Nedávno USA a několik západních zemí oznámily nové vojenské dodávky do Kyjeva, včetně bojových tanků, obrněných vozidel pěchoty a dělostřeleckých systémů.

Minulý měsíc došlo v Doněcku k tvrdým bitvám s ruskými silami, které úspěšně osvobodily strategické město Soledar. Dobytí strategické osady umožní přerušit zásobovací trasy používané ukrajinskými silami v nedalekém Artemovsku (Bachmut).

Jedna osoba byla zraněna při ukrajinském ostřelování Melitopolu -
Úřady

Nejméně jeden člověk byl zraněn v důsledku ostřelování města Melitopol ukrajinskými jednotkami, řekl Sputniku Vladimir Rogov, člen hlavní rady Záporožské regionální správy.

Ukrajínští vojáci ostřelovali Melitopol v pátek pozdě večer; ve městě se spustila protivzdušná obrana.

"Fragmenty jedné z raket dopadly na dva soukromé domy nedaleko nádraží. V tuto chvíli jsou informace o jednom zraněném. Tyto údaje se ověřují," řekl Rogov.

Dodal, že podle předběžných údajů ukrajinské jednotky ostřelovaly Melitopol pomocí raketového systému High Mobility Artillery Rocket System dodaného USA.

Rogov řekl Sputniku, že zprávy ukrajinských médií o údajných explozích na letišti Melitopol jsou nepravdivé. "Na letišti je vše v klidu. Nejsou tam žádné přílety a výbuchy. To je další před 15 hodinami

Švýcarsko odmítlo nabídku Španělska na reexport zbraní na Ukrajinu

Švýcarská vláda odmítla žádost Španělska, aby jí umožnilo poslat na Ukrajinu protiletadlová děla švýcarské výroby, uvedl v pátek mluvčí Státního sekretariátu pro hospodářské záležitosti.

"Švýcarsko odmítlo žádost Španělska ze dne 16. ledna 2023 o reexport dvou švýcarských 35mm protiletadlových kanónů na Ukrajinu," uvedl Fabian Maienfisch v prohlášení, které viděl Sputnik.

Švýcarský federální zákon o válečném materiálu vyžaduje, aby země, které nakupují švýcarské zbraně, požádaly o výjimku z prohlášení o nereexportu.

Neutral Switzerland does not allow the transfer of its weapons to conflict zones but its parliament is considering two bills that will create a legal basis for deliveries of Swiss arms to Ukraine. Votes on them are expected in spring or summer.

US Remains Noncommittal on Ukraine Fighter Jet Request, OSCE Envoy Says

The United States remains noncommittal on the issue of providing Ukraine with fighter jets, US Ambassador to the OSCE Michael Carpenter said on Friday.

Volodymyr Zelensky has been lobbying Western countries to provide modern fighter jets to help battle Russian forces, calling them "wings for freedom" in a speech to British lawmakers earlier this week in London.

Ukraine's wish list includes US-manufactured F-16 jets.

Evacuation of Civilians From Ugledar to Volnovakha Begins, DPR Acting Head Says

Acting head of the Donetsk People's Republic (DPR) Denis Pushilin announced on Friday the beginning of the evacuation of civilians from Ugledar to Volnovakha.

"Now there are about a thousand people in the city — civilians. We have already started to evacuate some of them when the active phase of liberation began," Pushilin told reporters, adding that the civilians have been moved to a relatively safe place — Volnovakha.

The Russian military has gained a foothold in the southern part of Ugledar, but Kiev continues to transfer reserves to the city, Pushilin added.

Zelensky Meets With Belgian King Philippe I in Brussels

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky met with Belgian King Philippe I, thanked Belgium for support to Ukraine during the military conflict with Russia, and also discussed his peace formula, Ukraine's presidential office said on Friday.

Zelensky is paying a visit to Brussels from February 9-10 where he also participated in the EU summit.

"President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelensky had an audience with His Majesty King Philippe I of Belgium in Brussels. The Head of State expressed gratitude to King Philippe, the Belgian government and the entire Belgian people for the comprehensive support provided to Ukraine," the statement read.

During the meeting, Zelensky also spoke about his peace formula for the settlement of the year-long military conflict with Russia.

West, Ukraine Pushing Moldova to Abandon Neutrality, Senior Russian Diplomat Says

Western countries and Ukraine are pushing Moldova to abandon neutrality, which could put an end to efforts to reach a settlement on breakaway Transnistria, Director of the Second Department of the Commonwealth of Independent States of the Russian Foreign Ministry Alexey Polishchuk told Sputnik.

"Unfortunately, we see how the West and Kiev are pushing Kishinev to abandon its neutrality enshrined in the country's constitution. The same thing happened to Ukraine some time ago and Moldova is being made to follow the same steps today," the senior diplomat stated.

Polishchuk said that if Kishinev gave up its neutral status it would "put an end to the Transnistrian settlement" as people in this region did not associate themselves with alliances that were against Russia.

"In the end, the abandonment of Moldova's neutrality would play into the hands of those [political] forces in Kishinev that are in favor of resolving the issue of Transnistria with the use of force," the diplomat added.

EU to Provide Financial Aid to States Hosting Ukrainian Refugees

The European Union will provide additional financial assistance to the member states that are incurring the highest costs from hosting Ukrainian refugees, according to the conclusions of a special meeting of the European Council.

"The European Union reiterates its commitment to reinforce support of displaced persons, both in Ukraine and in the European Union, including through adequate and flexible financial assistance to the Member States who carry the largest burden of medical, education and living costs of refugees," the council's statement, issued on Thursday, read.

The EU is currently hosting about four million Ukrainian refugees who fled the military operation that Russia launched in their country a year ago. The program for the admission of Ukrainian refugees will reportedly operate at least until March 2024.

Kremlin Says Unaware of Allegedly Intercepted 'Russia's Plan to Destabilize' Moldova

The Kremlin does not know what allegedly intercepted "plan to destabilize" the situation in Moldova Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky was talking about, Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said

on Friday.

On Thursday, Zelensky said in an address at the European Council that Ukraine's intelligence allegedly intercepted "Russia's plan to destabilize the democratic order" in Moldova. Zelenskyy informed Moldovan President Maia Sandu about this issue.

"It is necessary to inquire about this with Mr. Zelensky, we do not know what it is about," Peskov told a briefing.

Moldovan Foreign Ministry Summons Russian Ambassador Over Country's Airspace Violation

The Moldovan Foreign Ministry has summoned Russian Ambassador to Kishinev Oleg Vasnetsov in connection with the reports about the violation of Moldova's airspace by a missile, the ministry spokesman Daniel Voda said on Friday.

Earlier in the day, the Moldovan Defense Ministry confirmed that a missile heading towards Ukraine had violated Moldova's airspace.

"The head of Moldovan diplomacy, Nicu Popescu, ordered that Russian Ambassador in Chisinau Oleg Vasnetsov be urgently summoned to the Foreign Ministry to point out to the Russian side an unacceptable violation of our airspace in the form of a Russian missile flying over the sovereign territory of Moldova," Voda told reporters.

Kishinev Says Missile Heading Towards Ukraine Crossed Moldova's Airspace

The Moldovan Defense Ministry confirmed on Friday that a missile heading towards Ukraine has violated Moldova's airspace.

A source in the ministry told Sputnik earlier in the day that the ministry was verifying media reports claiming that several Russian missiles allegedly violated the airspace of Moldova.

"The responsible ... [authorities] discovered at 10:18 [local time, 08:18 GMT] a rocket that crossed the airspace of Moldova over the city of Mocra in the Transnistrian region, and then over the city of Cosauti ... The missile was heading towards Ukraine," the ministry said.

Moldova is closely monitoring the situation in the region and strongly condemns the violation of its airspace, the ministry added. Yesterday
