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Válka na Ukrajině skončí třeskem - brzy

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Uprostřed rozhořčených reakcí na odhalení bývalé kancléřky [Angely Merkelové](#) o dohodách z Minsku, obavy z toho, že Američané „radí“ Ukrajincům *en situ*, a bojové linie tam a zpět, je snadné zapomenout, o čem je válka na Ukrajině: o boji Spojených států udržet si status jediné světové supervelmoci. Přesněji řečeno, americký pokus potlačit Čínu jako konkurenční supervelmoc je středem této tragédie.

Čína, která je spojena se svou zadní čerpací stanicí Ruskem, je téměř neporazitelným nepřítelem. Čínské námořní přístavy mohou být snadno odříznuty, pokud hrozí, že tam zakotví kontejnerové lodě. Jeho zadní vrátka jsou jiná věc. Takže tito otrlí lidé ve Washingtonu, posedlí Wolfowitzovou doktrínou, potřebují zlikvidovat nebo převzít Rusko. To je sine qua non americké strategie. Bez tohoto kroku se strategie rozpadne.

A ten krok je potřeba udělat rychle; konfrontace s Čínou již nabírá na síle.

Proto válka na Ukrajině. Jak prohlásil prezident Biden, „[Putin] nemůže zůstat u moci“. Později poznámku vrátil, ale úryvek zjevně odráží myšlení v Oválné pracovně. Pěkný způsob, jak ho odstranit, je způsobit ruskou porážku na Ukrajině a rezignaci – nebo ještě hůř – jejího prezidenta, nahrazeného (neocons doufají) poddajným opilcem jako Boris Jelcin. Představoval bych si, že zahraničněpolitici blobéři se už dávno přesvědčili, že by ve skutečnosti raději dělali věci tímto způsobem. Protože jiná cesta není hezká.

Není to vůbec hezké: druhou možností je jaderný útok. Invaze do Ruska nepomůže. Rusové by to viděli na míli daleko. A nestáli by za konvenční válku na svém území, protože vědí, že by prohráli. Ani by nestáli za dalšího Jelcina, ani za cizího vládce, který by zemi rozbil na deset kusů. Dlouho předtím, než se Yankeeové dostali na dosah od Moskvy HIMARS, se Rusko uchýlilo k jaderným zbraním.

Učenci z Washingtonu to vědí, protože vždy věděli, že Rusko nemůže prohrát konvenční válku proti Ukrajině: rovná země na jejích hranicích, s třetinovou populací a žádnými skutečnými válečnými zdroji kromě herec-prezident, který – úvěr tam, kde je úvěr splatný – mohl prodávat písek na Sahaře. Dal bych mu jeho bustu v sálech Kongresu jen pro čirý chutzpah.

Protože konvenční útok je nemožný, Washington potřebuje válku přímo na ruských hranicích, kterou by mohl použít jako záminku pro jaderný útok. Pokud pochybujete o jejich odhodlání, pamatujte, že tento bezohledný gambit v mezinárodních záležitostech byl vybudován prostřednictvím čtyř administrativ neokonzervativců,

kteří: 1) zrušili příslušné smlouvy o kontrole zbrojení; 2) svrhl demokraticky zvolený režim na ruských hranicích; 3) oddělil Evropu od Ruska a zničil evropskou ekonomiku; a 4) doslova zničil plynovod NordStream, aby se ujistil, že vrak zůstane zničený. Dovedu si představit, že i mezi staršími praktiky americké zahraniční politiky – Kissingerem, Bakerem a jejich partou – tato opatření musela pozvednout pár obočí. Bidenova parta je jako patnáctiletí puštění v zahraničněpolitické cukrárně.

Podle mého názoru existují dva způsoby, jak válka vyprovokovat jadernou krizi: pokud do války vstoupí Spojené státy a/nebo NATO, nebo pokud Ukrajinci nějakým způsobem zaútočí chemickými nebo biologickými zbraněmi proti Rusku, možná špinavá bomba. V obou případech vypukne krize, dojde k výhrůžkám a USA mají výmluvu, aby rozpoutaly jaderný útok na Rusko – možná jen s minimem taktických jaderných zbraní, které by vynutily kapitulaci, protože jen Bůh a CIA vědí, co mohou Američané vlastně dělat.

Jde o to mít věrohodnou omluvu pro první úder; bez ukrajinské války by důvěryhodnost byla problematická – nebo alespoň problematičtější; Nepochybuji o tom, že ti samí agilní spisovatelé, kteří nám dali Kennedyho vraždu a 11. září, dokázali vymyslet živý příběh. Ať je to cokoli, veřejnost to přijme, protože byla pečlivě kultivována mediálními příběhy o Rusku: jak se Putin proměnil v diktátora, jak je pronásledována LGBT komunita, jak ruští muži uprchli ze země, aby se vyhnuli odvodu, a zejména, opakovaně, dunivě jako bubnování na heavy-metalovou melodii, že *Vladimir Putin je šílenec, megaloman*.

Když se objeví první snímky rozstřílené Moskvy, vysvětlí prezident Biden vyděšenému světu své srdcervoucí rozhodnutí udeřit jako první: kryty sibiřských raketových sil byly odstraněny, rádiový provoz byl nezaměnitelný, humint a e-lint potvrzeny. Podezření, ruská vojenská jednotka náhle zmizela do velitelských center po celé zemi a vrcholný dotek: nedávný duševní stav prezidenta Putina byl

„extrémně znepokojivý“. Jeho prohlášení musí být jen pouhou ozdobou okna; veřejnost, ač zděšená, si oddechne, když zjistí, že tento šílenec už není.

Prezident Biden by něco takového nikdy neudělal? Tento dědeček s mlhavou hlavou by mohl být plně proti třetí světové válce, ale jeho zahraničněpolitický tým už na něj vzal opatření a přesně ví, co říct, aby ho zpanikařil a začal jednat.

Posádka zahraniční politiky se bojí jaderné reakce od Putina? Stěží. Zdá se, že také přijali Rusovo opatření a odcházejí spokojeni. Putin nereagoval, když: 1) NATO se znovu a znovu rozšiřovalo; 2)

Washington provedl v Kyjevě státní převrat; 3) Washington (jediný skutečný podezřelý, ať už praktický nebo ne) sabotoval plynovod NordStream 2; a 4) když Washington asistoval ukrajinské vládě při útoku na Donbas. novel, the ramifications unexplored, and the deterrents to it totally untested. There is no clear path to Mutually Assured Destruction by the Russians and Americans from Russian use of thermonuclear weapons in Ukraine against the Ukrainian army. The US has said there would be retaliation, but it would not be nuclear.

[4] Rain stopped on 20 January but resumed two days later. On January 27 Lower Otay Dam broke, increasing the devastation and reportedly causing about 20 deaths (accounts vary on the exact number).[citation needed]

Hatfield talked to the press on February 4 and said that the damage was not his fault and that the city should have taken adequate precautions. Hatfield had fulfilled the requirements of his contract—filling the reservoir—but the city council refused to pay the money unless Hatfield would accept liability for damages; there were already claims worth \$3.5 million. Besides, there was no written contract. Hatfield tried to settle for \$4000 and then sued the council.[4] In two trials, the rain was ruled an act of God but Hatfield continued the suit until 1938 when two courts decided that the rain was an act of God, which absolved him of any wrongdoing, but also meant he did not get his fee.[4]

Bernstein declared in an interview and in an article in the Bulletin of Atomic Scientists published Monday that an American plant, “probably in Vigo County” near Terre Haute, Ind., was scheduled to make about 50,000 bombs monthly by the summer of 1944, and 250,000 by that year’s end.”

“In documents examined by Bernstein, British Prime Minister Winston Churchill was advised that 1,000 projectiles, each of 500 pounds and containing 106 four-pound anthrax bombs, could destroy life in a 25-square-mile area. Potential targets included Berlin, Hamburg, Frankfurt, Aachen and Wilhelmshafen.”

“Bernstein said the British contracted for anthrax bomb plants in the United States because such plants in Britain would be vulnerable to bombing and therefore a greater threat to the local population.”

“It is impossible to know how many bombs were made (after the initial order was filled) because the American records were either destroyed, lost or classified,” Barton said. “But it’s likely that other bombs were made, and I would love to know what the U.S. did with them.”

“The head of the British Medical Council’s Bacteriological Metabolic Unit unleashed anthrax experimentally on the small island of Gruinart, off the Scottish coast, soon after the war began. The island remains uninhabitable today.”

You have quite a point. I long have had my capabilities as a geopolitical and policy theorist and I want to go back to something I said a long time ago.

Around the time of the first Gulf War, I was discussing the Colin Powell military doctrine, which is that you first accumulate overwhelming force, and only then act militarily, with my brother, who also understands this stuff pretty well for a computer nerd.

What I said at that time was, the other alternative is to use all available force immediately.

The Russians under Putin have done neither. They did not use all available force immediately and they apparently are not intent on assembling overwhelming force to the limit of their capacity either.

The Powell doctrine especially applies to a situation where you are facing a war adversary which is inferior in power but which nevertheless possesses some dangerous capabilities.

Against a peer power, such as Japan was in World War II, maybe you use what forces you possess judiciously in the beginning in order to preserve your forces as much as possible for later when your forces finally are built up to a maximum level.

Ukraine is not a peer to Russia. Even with some greater amount of Western aid, it still will not be a peer to Russia. What Russia is doing militarily is perhaps inexplicable. Splitting the difference between using all available force immediately and holding back until you assemble overwhelming force is good way to drag

things out and multiply the strategic and geopolitical hazards you are facing, including the great hazard of escalation to nuclear war.

Some people might level the same accusation against the West – that the West neither used all available force immediately even in the context not being able to intervene militarily nor has the West moved to build up a maximum possible force. The problem for the West is, that outside of war production, the West is not capable of maximum effort. The Western European countries are capable of contributing units – a battalion or a regiment or two – but not whole armies. In the case of America, America’s youth and young adults are too debilitated for America to raise a mass army. According to sources, about 75 percent of the young men of military age are unqualified to serve. Some large percentage of the young men with some education would resist serving in the military. Many minority men might see a war in Eastern Europe as a “white man’s conflict,” and rightly so.

Seriously, I doubt at this point that the United States could put more than 300,000 actual front-line combat troops in the field and there would be no great stream of replacements behind them either. Among the Europeans, the Poles might be willing to fight in some numbers. But who else? Involving German units would be just about unthinkable.

Are we at a point where we have a conflict that no one has the capability to finish? Is this the war that everyone loses? I vote for the latter. Ukraine loses because it loses territory and, in the end, has to turn to Russia to protect its existing Western border. Russian loses because its vaunted conventional warfare capabilities have been exposed as wanting. America loses because it is exposed as lacking the capability to fight a major war. Western Europe is exposed as the squabbling mess it always

has been and as weak-willed and insipid. Eastern Europe is exposed as irrational and warmongering and as a region that has to be kept under the control by the big powers.

Who wins? Well, Russia wins a little, but at the price of generations of enmity and the exposure of its inadequacies as a land power, which means that Russian win a little and loses a lot. Everyone else just loses.

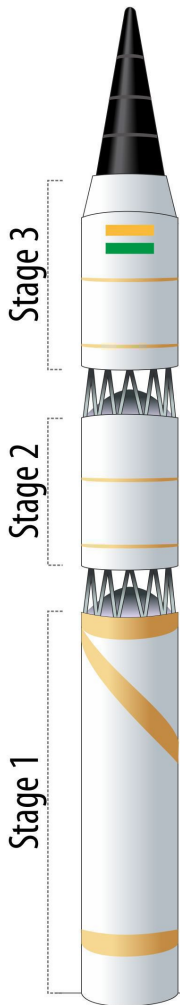

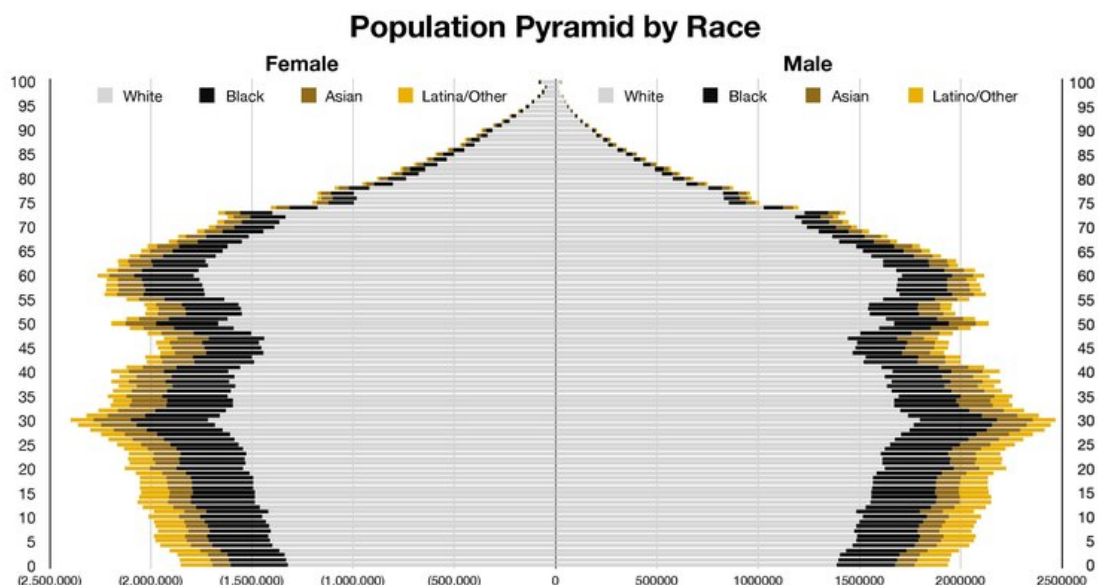
