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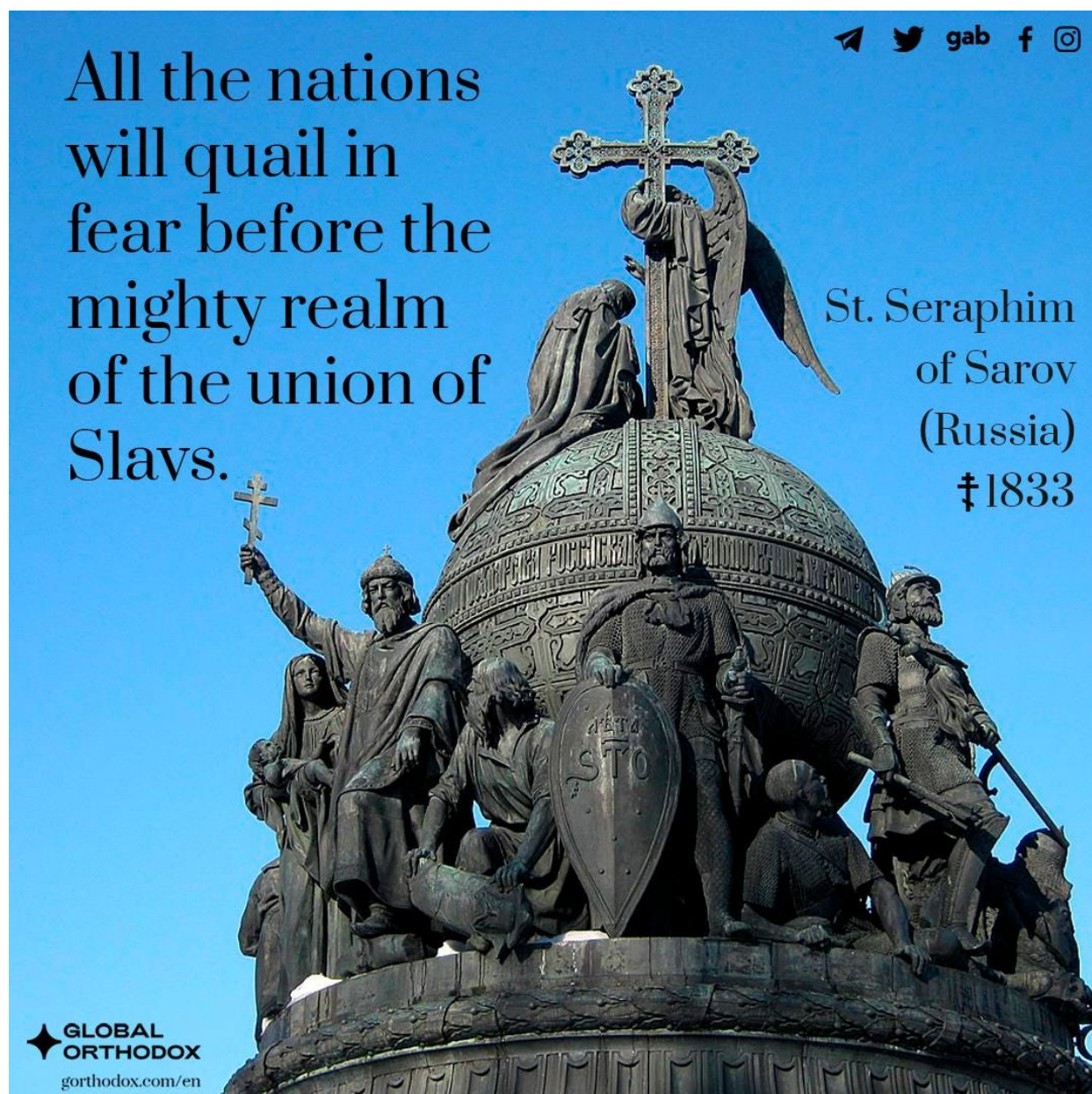

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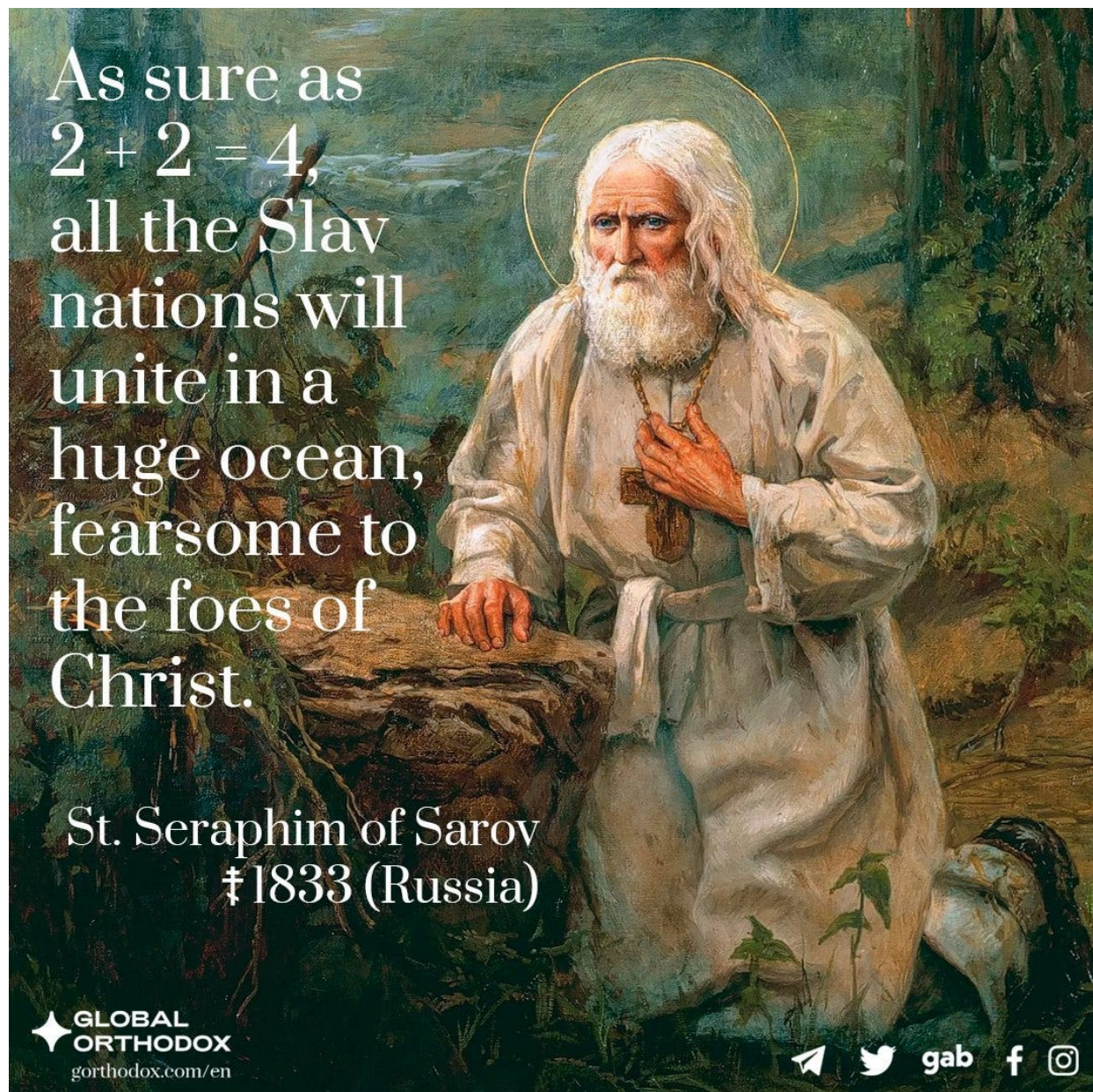
Ptáte se, když je tak mocná, proč visí mnohem menší Ukrajina? Z mnoha důvodů, za prvé, Rusko nebojuje totální válku, protože má zájem na tom, aby byla „ukrajinská“ infrastruktura co nejvíce nepoškozená, a to jak části, které se stanou součástí Ruska, tak ty, které se nestanou. 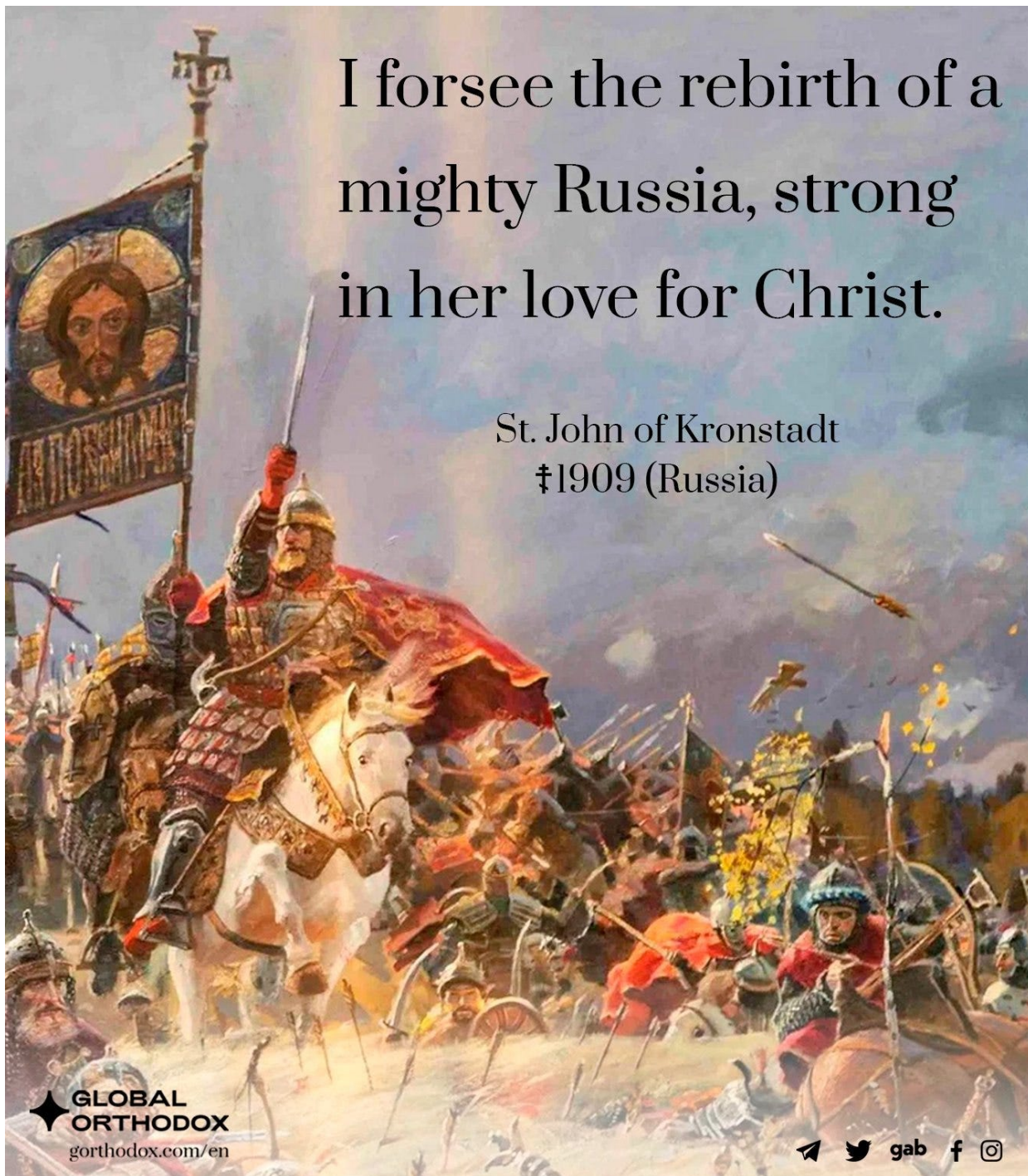

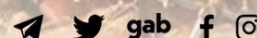

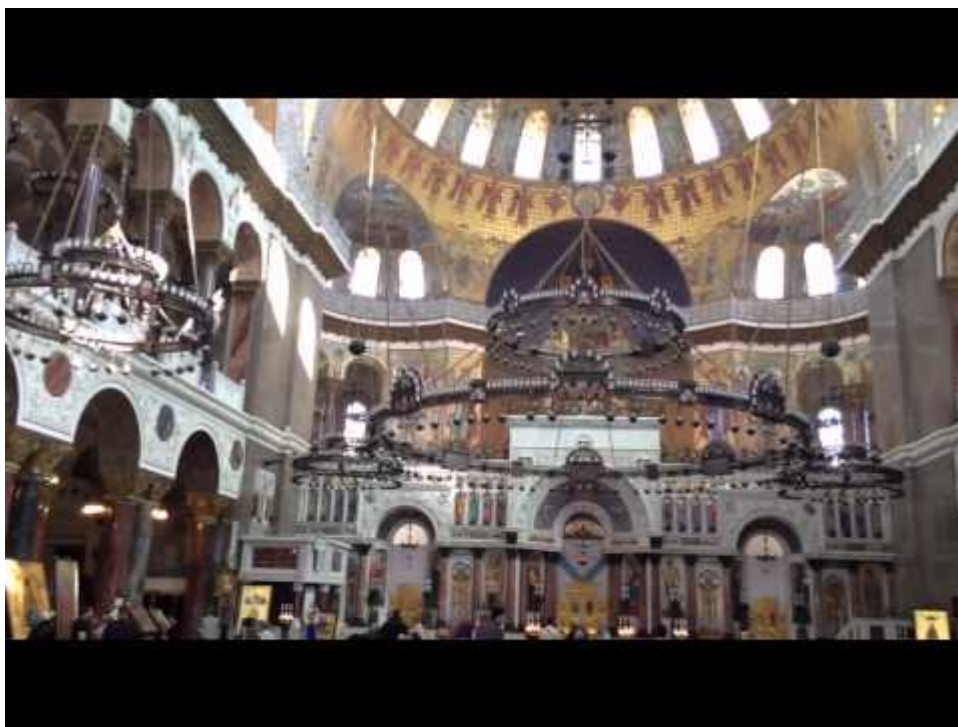

Truly amazing answer by former French Prime Minister Dominique de Villepin to a student who asks him if the EU will ever be independent from the US. In his response he calls the current situation one of "tutelage of the U.S. over Europe", mostly via NATO whose "European pillar" he calls "incredibly weak". He says this is a "gigantic issue" because Europe cannot "hope to live between the US and China" if it doesn't gain its independence and its "political sovereignty". In particular he says that in the current situation it makes no sense for Global South countries to speak to Europe "if the decisions are to be made in Washington".

He also believes that current plans to enlarge the EU "will only make the situation ever worse and will reinforce even more this link of dependence". He said he'd been "very struck" when he was France's Foreign Minister in a previous EU enlargement round to see that "most states joined the EU in fact for the purpose of strengthening their links with NATO and that their primary objective was NATO... In their mind it was the protection, the umbrella given by the United States."

I think this is the first time – to my knowledge – that a former French PM so directly admits that EU is not an independent entity, but instead under US tutelage.

Of course, joining NATO doesn't offer protection. Just bribes for the collaborator elites.

The War in Ukraine Is Already Over—Russia Just Doesn't Know it Yet

Wars end long before armistices are signed. A war's end, after all, is a matter of will, of spirit—and popular will is only haltingly, grudgingly reflected in the political machinery of peace talks.

Though it may seem astonishingly premature to say so, my impression after returning from the Russian front is that the war in Ukraine is over and that the powers that be haven't realized it yet. In the Kursk salient, at least, I can personally attest to the eerie, almost surreal inversion of spirits between the people of Ukraine and Russia. The moral scales have now firmly settled on the side of the Ukrainian defenders, and it is far likelier that Russia itself splinters into its constituent republics than that Ukraine falls to its erstwhile invaders.

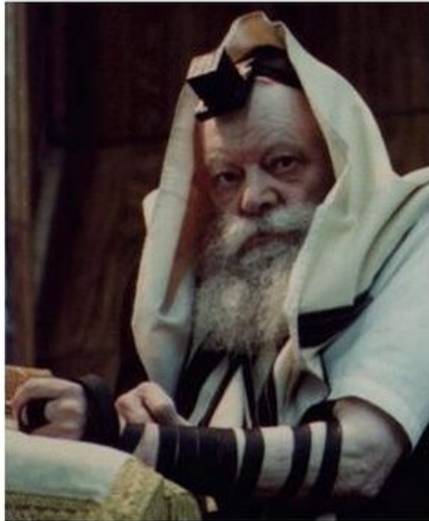

The argument could be made that FDR won the war against Imperial Japan (1942-1945) during his first two terms, when he established or improved several shipyards on the US West Coast. Those shipyards repaired / replaced / augmented to the US aircraft carrier fleet. That aircraft carrier fleet destroyed the Imperial Japanese Navy (IJN).

The original, pre-FDR, US Navy contingency plan for responding to an IJN assault was to gather its capital ships, armed with high caliber naval rifles and heavily armored. The gathered fleet was to have proceeded to Japan and, on the way, destroy the IJN. That was essentially a repetition of the Imperial Russian strategy that led to the Russian fleets' destruction in 1905. Japanese carriers and Long Lance torpedoes would likely have destroyed the US fleet.

Fortunately or otherwise, the armored/naval rifle ships that were to defeat the IJN were destroyed or disabled during the Pearl Harbor raid, 1942-12, and the US turned to its aircraft carrier force, which did destroy most of the IJN. The nucleus of the US aircraft carrier force was at sea when the IJN raided Pearl Harbor; this was so unlikely as not to be a coincidence, IMHO.

The US empire is of the suzerainty kind. A suzerain is a country that rules client countries through local governments. The rule is ordinarily enforced by “suggestions that the client state do such and such lest the suzerain deploy military forces, or perhaps simply tells other client states to boycott the client state’s businesses. <https://www.merriam-webster.com/dictionary/suzerain>

So what happens to suzerains after the initial conquest?

- a) They become corrupt and unable to rule the conquered areas.
- b) They are replaced by a much less corrupt system that can last for centuries but eventually fails, as have all human works thus far.

Suzerainty has the advantage of reducing both administrative costs and military costs. Further, it can leave the problem of border defense to the client countries. The early Roman Empire was a suzerainty. Strictly speaking there was no Empire back then, just the Roman Republic and its conquests. Rome had a separate treaty with each conquest. Rome collected tribute, and the locals handled their borders.

The US now has suzerainty over the EU. As with the Roman Republic after the defeat of its principal rival, Carthage, the US is overwhelmed with immigration, minority rule by an internally divided aristocracy, and is facing a Money vs. Force crisis. At present (2024-09) former President Obama represents Money (Obama having seized power in 2014 [1] and subsequently acted to preserve his campaign contributors, the large banks), and the Red States (RS) represent Force (in that they could unilaterally withdraw from the US federal government). RS

withdrawal would be analogous to Caesar's crossing the Rubicon (a small river), and the US federal government would be analogous to the Senatorial reaction to crossing the Rubicon.

Under the Roman Empire, the conquests became provinces and Roman forces took over border enforcement. This resulted in gradual infiltration of provincials and "multi-cultural" barbarians into Roman areas. The result contributed heavily to the Crisis of the Third Century [2]) and the later (AD 340s) failure of the Western Empire under Justinian (which plague killed about 50% to 60% of the Roman Empire's population because it struck both city and countryside, and drastically reduced Empire's military forces, and marked the start of the Late Antique Little Ice Age and its plagues) [3].

Russia's Investigative Committee identifies suspects in murder of Sputnik's Russell Bentley

The Russian Investigative Committee has wrapped up the preliminary investigation into the murder of Russell Bentley, 64, a US-born Donbass volunteer and Sputnik correspondent.

Suspects involved in the criminal case were identified as Russian Armed Forces servicemen Vitaly Vansyatsky, Vladislav Agaltsev, Vladimir Bazhin, and Andrey Iordanov. The individuals have been accused of felonies under Russia's Criminal Code, including the use of physical violence and torture, which resulted in the death of the victim through negligence, as well as the concealment of an especially grievous crime.

On April 8, Russian military servicemen Vansyatsky, Agaltsev, and Iordanov used physical violence and torture against Russell Bentley in Donetsk, which led to the correspondent's death. On the same day, Vansyatsky and Agaltsev blew up a VAZ 2115 car with Bentley's body with TNT explosives.

On April 9, Bazhin, a serviceman from the same military unit removed Bentley's remains from the scene on the instructions of Vansyatsky in a bid to conceal the heinous crime. The accused have been provided with the materials of criminal case. Subsequently, the case will be transferred for the indictment approval and court hearings.

Bentley went to Donbass in 2014 and joined the Donetsk People's Republic (DPR) militia using the call sign Texas. He said that he admired the courage of the Donbass defenders and called Donetsk his home. The US-born volunteer was granted Russian citizenship and began collaborating with Sputnik as a correspondent. He was known as an outspoken supporter of the Russian special military operation in Ukraine.

In mid-April, Bentley went missing in Donetsk. On April 19, Margarita Simonyan, editor-in-chief of Rossiya Segodnya, Sputnik's parent media group, announced that the 64-year-old had died. An investigation into the circumstances of Bentley's death was launched by the Russian Investigative Committee.

He seemed to have died from a heart attack after being tazered. I think Marat Khairullin suspected them of being ex-Wagner who joined the Russian army after their contracts ran out.

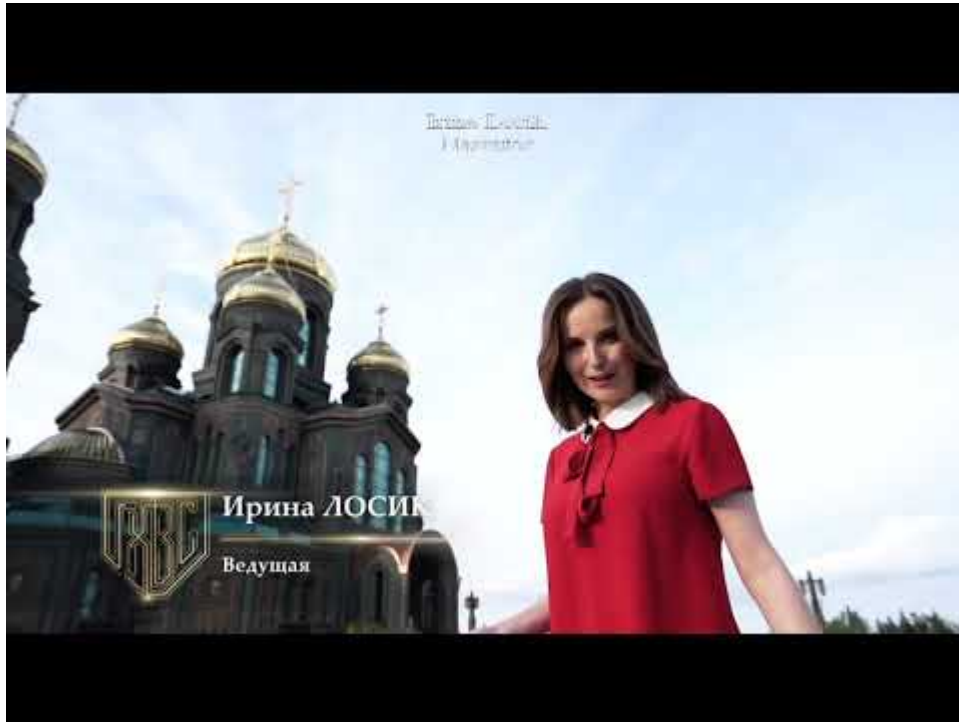
