Vzpomínám si, že když jsem od poloviny do konce 60. a začátku 70. let navštěvoval základní školu St. Albert Veliký v Burbanku ve státě Illinois, někteří učitelé dějepisu nám říkali, že Spojené státy nikdy neprohrály žádnou válku. Mějte na paměti, že to bylo v době, kdy se odehrávalo pošetilé americké fiasko ve Vietnamu, a to bylo jen deset nebo dvě desetiletí po bezvýsledné patové situaci korejské války. To vám ukazuje, že indoktrinace školních dětí není nic nového. Pro vojensko-průmyslové impérium, které udržuje přibližně 800 vojenských základen po celém světě a které <u>utrácí na svou armádu</u> více než dalších sedm zemí (a také 144 dalších zemí) dohromady, se

globální hegemonické impérium USA dnes zjevně hroutí před našima očima, po desetiletích pomalého rozkladu. Poslední válkou, kterou USA jednoznačně vyhrály, byla druhá světová válka – a to vítězství bylo možné jen díky bojům Sovětského svazu, Velké Británie a dalších spojenců kromě Ameriky. To velké vítězství bylo před téměř 80 lety.

Od té doby se americký vojensko-průmyslový komplex potácel od jednoho vojenského debaklu k druhému v téměř neustálém válečném stavu, přičemž každý konflikt se vyznačoval buď případným selháním, nebo v nejlepším případě nejednoznačnými výsledky. Mnoho geopolitických nepořádků vytvořených těmito americkými vojenskými intervencemi bylo nicméně pro třídu elitních válečných štváčů velmi finančně výnosné. A koneckonců, USA tvrdí, že jsou "výjimečné" mezi národy, takže mají samozřejmé právo vměšovat se, kdekoli a kdykoli chtějí, bez ohledu na negativní důsledky. Brzy po druhé světové válce došlo ke korejské válce, ve které komunisté vyhráli severní část tohoto národa navzdory vojenskému úsilí USA. Pak tu byla vietnamská válka s mnohaletou devastací způsobenou USA, která skončila stažením amerických jednotek, tvrdě poražených komunisty, kteří ovládli celou zemi. Ale co se vlastně v Iráku podařilo? Statisíce mrtvých civilistů, hromadné ničení a <u>společenské devastace</u>, stejně jako podstatně zhoršená destabilizace celého Blízkého východu, vedoucí k posílení moci Íránu, nárůstu islamistického terorismu a dalšímu ostudnému

stažení USA. A jako by to nezpůsobilo dostatečný chaos v regionu, USA o několik let později zničily další národ a dále destabilizovaly Blízký východ zabitím dalšího údajného padoucha v Libyi. Samozřejmě, že nejkřiklavější nedávná americká porážka a stažení přišla na konci nejdelší americké války v Afghánistánu. Po 20 letech amerického vojenského vměšování a masakrů v Afghánistánu se tamní padouši, které USA údajně rozpoutaly válku, aby je sesadily, vrátili k moci . Zdánlivě další spektakulární porážka amerického impéria, ačkoli tento konflikt odsouzený k záhubě byl úmyslně ukončen, aby americké vojenské zdroje mohly být odkloněny jinam, jmenovitě k novému nesmyslnému boji ve východní Evropě. Kromě těchto dobře známých amerických válek od 50. let do současnosti USA za tutéž dobu podnítily, zahájily a byly zapojeny do stovek dalších vojenských konfliktů (prostřednictvím skutečných bojů, bojů v zastoupení, dodávek zbraní a peněz, nebo různé jiné formy vměšování), jak zjevně, tak skrytě, všude – od Střední a Jižní Ameriky přes Blízký východ a severní a subsaharskou Afriku po jižní, střední a východní Asii až po střední a východní Evropu. Hlavními výsledky těchto konfliktů bylo v podstatě sakra hodně zabíjení, chaosu a ničení a celkové zhoršování problémů v cizích zemích, s absolutně žádnými výhodami pro americký lid (pokud nepracujete pro Pentagon nebo nejste manažer . s velkým dodavatelem obrany). A tak jsme dnes tady. Zatímco píšu tato slova, vojenská mašinérie Spojených států je zjevně na pokraji další velkolepé porážky – tentokrát proti ruským silám na Ukrajině. Tato hořká skutečnost byla skryta americkými a západními mainstreamovými korporátními médii, ale byla odborně formulována několika čestnými komentátory, jako je <u>Douglas Macgregor</u>. Další válka podněcovaná a vedená Spojenými státy prostřednictvím zastoupení proti imaginárnímu nepříteli z jiných důvodů, než je finanční zisk a klamný pocit udržování své zjevně ochromené a rychle se zmenšující světové hegemonie. Plýtvání cennými zdroji při ničení další cizí země, prosazování jakéhosi chorého neoliberálního probuzeného

programu, i když se zdá, že Amerika<u>kolabuje ve všech oblastech své</u> společnosti doma. Brilantně vnímavý Chris Hedges označil toto šílenství za "<u>probuzený imperialismus".</u>

Jo, takhle to pro ně dopadne lépe než ta jejich šíleně vyprovokovaná zástupná válka proti Rusku!

A pro budoucí úvahy nezapomeňte, že vždy existuje válka, která může být vytlačena proti Severní Koreji, Íránu nebo jakékoli jiné nezávislé zemi, která odmítá uznat hegemonii USA.

Normálnímu, racionálně uvažujícímu jedinci se nekonečné americké válečné štvaní po celém světě, které vždy končí trapnými a ponižujícími prohrami a dalším chaosem a šílenstvím, připadá krajně nelogické. Ale skrytá logika amerického vojensko-průmyslového komplexu spočívá ve velmi reálných finančních ziscích, které nadále sbírá, když se marně snaží udržet upadající americké impérium, bez ohledu na vojenské ztráty na místě. O tom to celé je. O tom to vždy bylo. Peníze. Chamtivost. Napájení. Řízení. Nevšímejte si smrti a ničení.

Netřeba dodávat, že tato klamná, sebevražedná situace nemůže trvat věčně. Nakonec se americké impérium vyčerpá a nakonec se totálně zhroutí. A pak váleční prospěcháři jednoduše změní stranu, pravděpodobně se přesunou do Číny. Mezitím se však uvadající americké impérium bude nadále chovat tak, jak se upadající říše v průběhu historie obvykle chovaly, od římského po britské impérium.

Italian Chamber of Deputies approves Meloni decree to restrict activity of migrant rescue boats in the Mediterranean

The Italian Chamber of Deputies has approved a government decree designed to limit the activity of humanitarian vessels escorting migrants from the Mediterranean to the shores of Italy.

The decree, announced by Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni in January, orders humanitarian vessels to head for the nearest port following a rescue at sea "without delay," preventing them from laying down anchor and waiting for more distress signals from other migrant boats.

The bill, which will enshrine the decree into primary legislation, was passed with 187 votes in favor, 139 against, and three abstentions.

The government is concerned the continual presence of the NGO boats operating in the region entices migrants to attempt the perilous journey from North Africa in their bid to reach Europe.

NGO boats that are found to be ignoring the new rules will have their captains fined up to  $\in$ 50,000 and their boats impounded.

Runner-up is the Industrial sector. It includes all of the major defense contractors: Raytheon [now the largest constituent of the Industrial sector, at a 5.13% weighting]; Boeing; Lockheed Martin; Northrup Grumman; and General Dynamics.
