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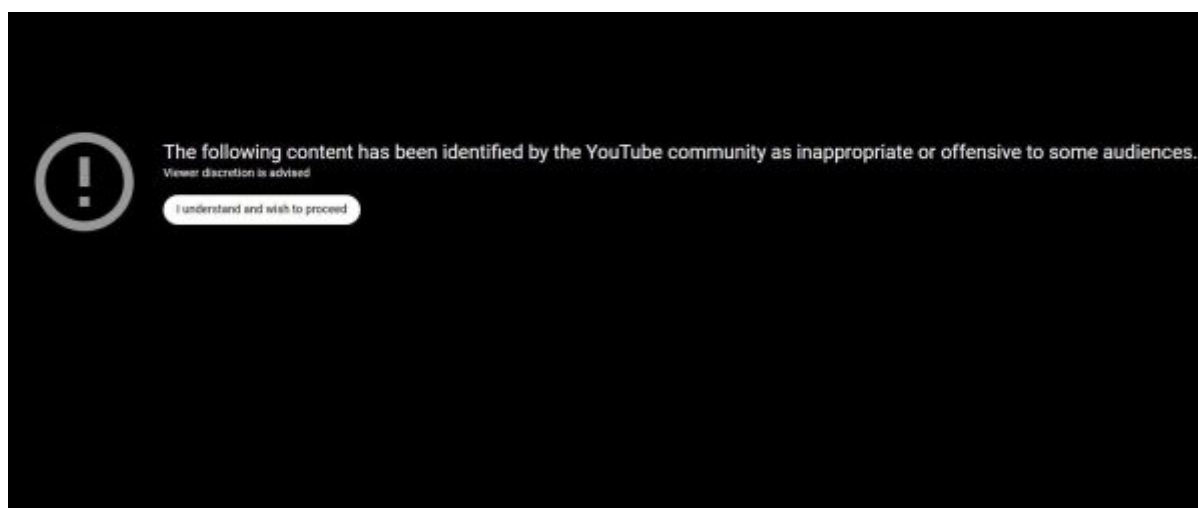

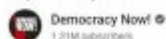

Hersh získal Pulitzerovu cenu před více než půl stoletím v roce 1970 jako zuřivě nezávislý reportér, který odhalil americký masakr v My Lai ve válce ve Vietnamu. Během následujících desetiletí v *New York Times* a *New Yorker* prolomil některé z největších příběhů v historii žurnalistiky, včetně domácích špionážních aktivit CIA, zneužívání věznic Abu Ghraib během války v Iráku a zabití Usámy bin Ládina. , přičemž byl oceněn dvěma National Magazine Awards, pěti George Polk Awards a mnoha dalšími oceněními .

Hershova dlouhá kariéra ho pravděpodobně řadí mezi nejrenomovanějšího žijícího amerického novináře a profesor Jeffrey Sachs z Kolumbijské univerzity ho tak v nedávném rozhovoru popsal. Brzy na to navázal půlhodinovým vystoupením v pořadu *Democracy Now* od Amy Goodmanové!, přední levicově-liberální zpravodajský pořad vysílaný na více než 1400 rozhlasových a televizních stanicích po celém světě, z nichž mnohé jsou pobočkami PBS a NPR.

Během tohoto rozhovoru Hersh reagoval na kritiku a vysvětlil, že ukrajinská válka s Ruskem se vyvíjí mnohem hůř, než uvádějí americká média. Podle Hershe a některých jeho vládních zdrojů mohl být americký útok na ropovody katastrofální chybou, která by mohla vyústit v kolaps NATO, jakmile si většina Evropanů uvědomí, co se stalo.

*Democracie hned!* má na svém velkém kanálu Youtube 1,3 milionu odběratelů a na této platformě okamžitě zveřejnil Hershův důležitý rozhovor. Během několika hodin se segment přiblížil k 250 000 zhlédnutí na cestě k pravděpodobně mnoha milionům, čímž se stal jedním z nejoblíbenějších videí kanálu. Samozřejmě jsem to propojil v několika komentářích na našem webu.

Ale ten samý den, kdy byla vydána, Youtube náhle zcenzuroval Hersh's *Democracy Now!* vzhled s tvrzením, že představuje „porušení komunitárních norem“ a je „urážlivý“:

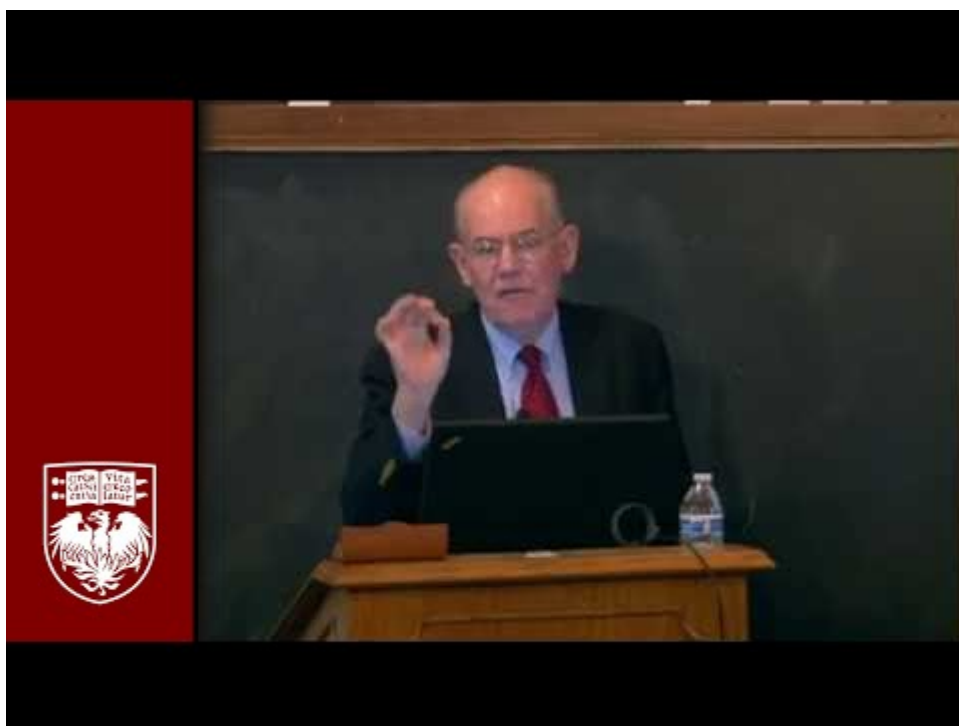
Jako výsledek, Hersh's *Democracy Now!* segment již nelze zobrazit nikde jinde než na samotném webu Youtube, a to až po prokliku dvěma vrstvami varování. Zřejmým záměrem bylo drasticky snížit Hershovo potenciální publikum a to se jistě podaří. Předpokládám,

že tato omezení byla kombinována s nejpřísnějším druhem stínového zákazu. Segment, který by pravděpodobně vidělo mnoho milionů, tedy získá jen malý zlomek z celkového počtu.

Takováto Youtube cenzura špičkového mainstreamového novináře na předním mainstreamovém kanálu se zdá zcela bezprecedentní, masivní eskalace předchozích opatření namířených proti politickému okraji. Tento krok byl pravděpodobně způsoben obavami z toho, jak Youtube dříve umožnil názorům jiných důležitých veřejných osobností obejít blokádu strážců médií :

Mearsheimerovy další rozhovory a přednášky na Ukrajině nashromáždily mnoho milionů dalších názorů a jako přímý důsledek jeho náhle obrovské internetové přítomnosti byl kdysi bojkotovaný akademik vyzván, aby přispíval dlouhými výklady svých názorů do

tak extrémně establishmentářských zdrojů, jako je *Economist* and *Foreign Affairs* a vybrali se k účasti na prestižních veřejných fórech, jako je kanadská Munk debata a evropská Holberg Debate . V důsledku toho byly pravděpodobně desítky milionů lidí po celém světě vystaveny perspektivě, která byla dříve vyloučena ze západních mainstreamových médií.

Diváci obou těchto pořadů jsou však vůči Bidenově administrativě již v drtivé většině nepřátelští, takže tyto segmenty by byly mnohem méně hroživé než Hershův vlastní dlouhý rozhovor s Amy Goodman

It's not so much that Hersh is restricted, but corporate PBS that normally supports the government narrative. Democracy Now is famous and has been up for years, it's no fringe program.

It's not so much the warnings, but to watch the video one must be signed up with a YouTube account and log on. Many will not bother and some don't want an account to track them for privacy reasons. That's another censor technique few are aware of. My Youtube channel has "edgy" historical videos, but none have been banned or restricted, although around 10% are demonetized. I was using Wi-Fi at a hospital and looked at my account and half my videos did not appear. I tried at my son's school and the same thing, half didn't appear. They don't appear as banned, they are just not there in my VIDEOS list. Youtube never informed me when my video was banned from public Wi-Fi, and I can find no guidelines they use.

I wonder if YouTube uses IP address to confuse its partners. If watching from my normal IP address maybe all looks good, but videos may be banned at others, or other states or countries.

The other point worth making is that the choice of Bakhmut/Arteymovsk was made by the Russians, not the Ukrainians.

Bakhmut's got enough fortifications to be plausibly defensible, but the defensive fortifications are not deep enough and there's not enough storage for ammo in case of a cut to supply lines.

If it had been up to the Ukrainians, they would have preferred to make their *Greatest Ever Defence* at Soledar – where they had the benefit of dozens (almost hundreds) of kilometers of tunnels in the salt mines, deep enough to be safe against portable thermobarics like those used by the TOS-1A.

Salt Mine #7 has tunnels that are 700m underground, and are tall enough and wide enough to dive a truck through. If someone set off a thermobaric in one of the ground-level entrances, anyone 'in the bowels' would barely feel a breeze.

The fact that Soledar fell so quickly (*modulo* the requirement to sweep & clear) was a bit of a shock.

There was some concern among Russian field units that the Ukrainians had rigged part of the extensive subterranean works – that could collapse the whole shebang once the Russians were on top of it.

The Russian command has enough knowledge of the Soviet era, to know that such a scenario was monumentally unlikely – as unlikely as being able to collapse Cheyenne Mountain in on itself from within, or of breaking containment at a Soviet-era nuclear plant using artillery.

The problem for Ukraine now is that this is really the 'all in' moment, and they have a 2-7 off-suit.

The fortifications between Bakhmut and Kramatorsk are of recent date and have been constructed in haste. They're not deep enough: anyone relying on them for shelter will have their lungs collapsed by a single MO.1.01.04 (the short range thermobaric munition for the TOS-1A).

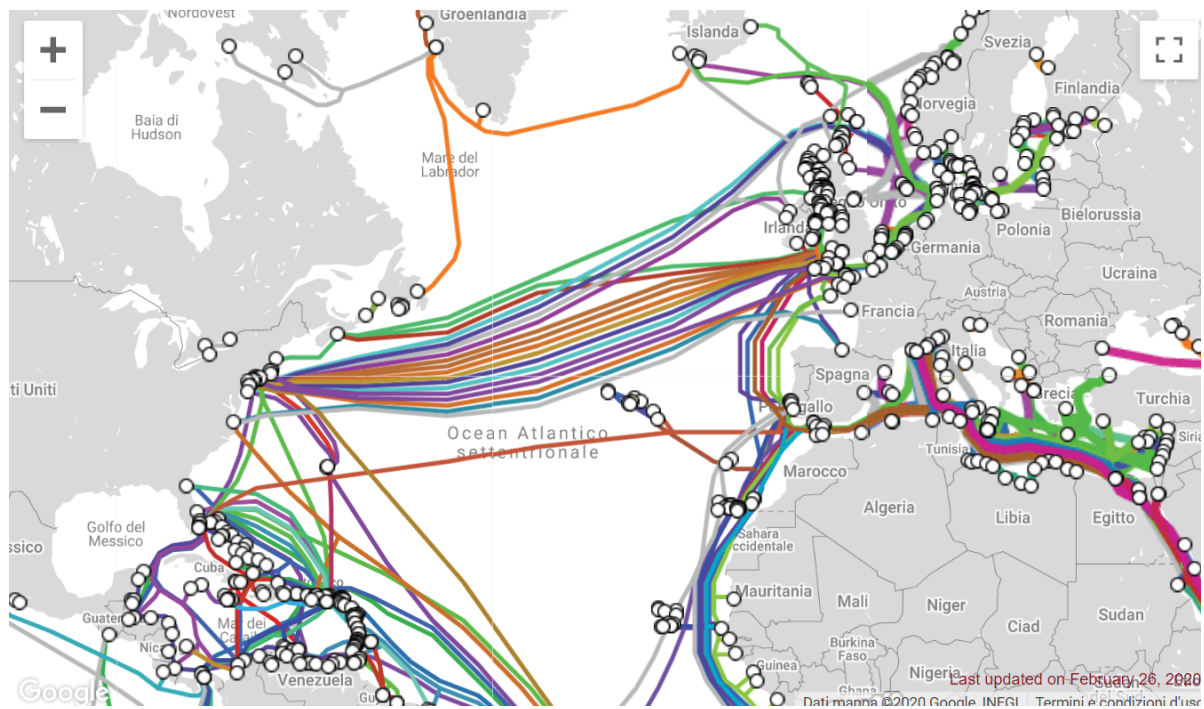

Underwater Internet cables can be replaced by satellite, but the electricity transmission lines are practically irreplaceable. They and oil and gas pipelines are thousands of kilometers long, and even NATO cannot deploy a guard submarine every kilometer.

Bribery is systematic, where it’s accepted as a basic fact of life by ordinary citizens and extends even to such mundane tasks as vehicle inspection. As well as infesting politics, bribery and other forms of corruption remain endemic in the police force, higher education, health care, and the justice system, with the result that Ukraine ranks alongside some of the worst African nations in Transparency International’s assessment of corruption perception. According to 2015 data, politically connected businesses accounting for less than 1 per cent of companies in Ukraine owned more than 25 per cent of all assets and accessed over 20 per cent of debt financing. In the capital-intensive mining, energy and transport sectors, politically connected businesses accounted for over 40 per cent of turnover and 50 per cent of assets.

Far from being the beacon of freedom presented to us now by the mass media, Ukraine is a nation bankrupt in social trust and well-accustomed to the yoke of exploitation. There has been little internal outcry over the massive trafficking of its women for sex, both inside and outside the country, with coastal cities such as Odessa becoming sex tourism hubs for the worst of the Turkish and Israeli middle classes. Ukraine now has the highest adult HIV prevalence outside Africa, with sexual contact outpacing injection drug use as the primary form of transmission since 2008. Kolomoisky is also a listed donor for Yad Vashem. Both Korf and Laber also held shares in PrivatBank, and are reported by The Forward as having pumped "about \$25 million into Jewish nonprofits between 2006 and 2018." Kolomoisky is of course the patron of "Menorah," the largest Jewish center in the world. Entirely appropriate given its existence is owed to international robber barons, the center is home to travel agencies and banks. The official website says that the building is something "every Dnipro resident can be proud of," to which I can only reply that I'd hope so given that, willingly or not, some of the savings and deposits of every Dnipro resident went into its construction.
