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Putinův „civilizační“ projev rámuje konflikt mezi Východem a Západem

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Tolik očekávaný projev ruského prezidenta Vladimira Putina v úterý před Federálním shromážděním Ruska by měl být interpretován jako cesta k suverenitě.

Tento projev významně připomněl první výročí oficiálního uznání Doněcké a Luhanské lidové republiky Ruskem, jen pár hodin před 22. únorem 2022. To, co se stalo před rokem, znamenalo nesčetnými způsoby také zrod skutečného, 21 · století v multipolárním světě. O dva dny později Moskva zahájila speciální vojenskou operaci (SMO) na Ukrajině na obranu zmíněných republik.

Chladný, klidný, sebraný, bez špetky agrese, Putinův projev vykreslil Rusko jako starověkou, nezávislou a zcela odlišnou civilizaci – někdy kráčí po cestě ve shodě s jinými civilizacemi, jindy se rozchází.

Ukrajina, součást ruské civilizace, je nyní shodou okolností okupována západní civilizací, o které Putin řekl, že „se k nám stala nepřátelskou“, jako v několika případech v minulosti. Akutní fáze toho, co je v podstatě válka v zastoupení Západu proti Rusku, se odehrává nad tělem ruské civilizace.

To vysvětluje Putinovo vysvětlení, že „Rusko je otevřená země, ale nezávislá civilizace – nepovažujeme se za nadřazené, ale zdědili jsme naši civilizaci po našich předcích a musíme ji předávat dál.“

Válka roztahující tělo ruské civilizace je vážným existenčním obchodem. Putin také jasně řekl, že „Ukrajinu Západ používá jako nástroj a testovací základnu proti Rusku“. Nevyhnutelné pokračování: „Čím více zbraní dlouhého doletu bude na Ukrajinu posláno, tím déle budeme muset odtlačit hrozbu od našich hranic.

Překlad: tato válka bude dlouhá – a bolestivá. Nedojde k žádnému rychlému vítězství s minimální ztrátou krve. Příští pohyby kolem Dněpru mohou trvat roky, než se zpevní. V závislosti na tom, zda se politika USA bude i nadále držet neokonzervativních a neoliberálních cílů, může být frontová linie přesunuta do Lvova. Pak se německá politika může změnit. Normální obchod s Francií a Německem může být obnoven až do konce příštího desetiletí.

Podráždění Kremlu: START skončil

To vše nás přivádí ke hrám, které hraje Empire of Lies. Putin říká: „Sliby...západních vládců se změnilly v padělky a kruté lži. Západ dodal zbraně, vycvičil nacionalistické prapory. Ještě před začátkem SMO probíhala jednání...o dodávkách systémů protivzdušné obrany...

Pamatujeme si pokusy Kyjeva získat jaderné zbraně.

Putin dal znovu jasně najevo, že prvek důvěry mezi Ruskem a Západem, zejména USA, je pryč. Pro Rusko je tedy přirozené rozhodnutí „odstoupit od smlouvy o strategických útočných zbraních, ale neděláme to oficiálně. Prozatím pouze zastavujeme naši účast na smlouvě START. Žádné americké inspekce v našich jaderných lokalitách nemohou být povoleny.“

Kromě toho, ze tří hlavních americko-ruských smluv o zbraních, Washington upustil od dvou z nich: Smlouva o protiraketové střele (ABM) byla zrušena administrativou bývalého prezidenta George W. Bushe v roce 2002 a jaderná smlouva středního doletu. Smlouvu o silách (INF) zrušil bývalý prezident Donald Trump v roce 2019. To ukazuje míru podráždění Kremlu. Putin je dokonce připraven nařídít ministerstvu obrany a Rosatomu, aby se připravily na testování ruských jaderných zbraní, pokud USA půjdou první po stejné cestě. Pokud tomu tak bude, Rusko bude nuceno zcela porušit paritu v jaderné sféře a opustit moratorium na jaderné testování a spolupráci s jinými státy, pokud jde o výrobu jaderných zbraní. Doposud hra USA a NATO spočívala v otevření malého okénka, které jim umožnilo inspekci ruských jaderných lokalit.

Putin svým pohybem v judu vrací tlak na Bílý dům.

USA a NATO nebudou zrovna nadšené, když Rusko začne testovat své nové strategické zbraně, zejména posoudní Poseidon – největší torpédo s jaderným pohonem, jaké kdy bylo rozmístěno, schopné spustit děsivé radioaktivní vlnobití oceánů.

Na ekonomické frontě: Obcházení amerického dolaru je zásadní hrou směrem k multipolaritě. Během svého projevu Putin vyzdvihl odolnost ruské ekonomiky: „Ruský HDP se v roce 2022 snížil pouze o 2,1 procenta, odhady odpůrců se nestaly skutečností, řekli o 15, 20 procenta. Tato odolnost dává Rusku dostatek prostoru, aby „pracovalo s partnery na tom, aby byl systém mezinárodního vypořádání nezávislý na americkém dolaru a dalších západních měnách. Dolar ztratí svou univerzální roli.“

O geoeconomii: Putin chválil ekonomické koridory, ze západní Asie do jižní Asie: „Budou se stavět nové koridory, dopravní cesty směrem na východ, to je region, kam zaměříme náš rozvoj, nové dálnice do Kazachstánu a Číny, nový severojižní koridor do Pákistánu, Íránu. A ty se spojí s Ruskem a rozvíjejí „přístavy Černého a Azovského moře, v zemi je nutné vybudovat logistické koridory“. Výsledkem bude progresivní propojení s Mezinárodním severojižním dopravním koridorem (INSTC), k jehož principům patří Írán a Indie a nakonec čínská iniciativa Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) za megabiliony dolarů.

Čínský plán pro globální bezpečnost

Je nevyhnutelné, že kromě načrtnutí několika státních politik zaměřených na vnitřní rozvoj Ruska – lze je dokonce přirovnat k socialistickým politikám – se Putinův projev musel soustředit na až do poslední Ukrajinské války NATO proti Rusku.

Putin poznamenal, že „naše vztahy se Západem se zhoršily a je to zcela vina Spojených států“. Jak je cílem NATO způsobit Rusku „strategickou porážku“; a jak ho před týdnem válečné štvání donutilo podepsat dekret „uvádějící nové pozemní strategické komplexy do bojové služby“.

Není tedy náhodou, že hned po Putinově projevu byl americký velvyslanec okamžitě předvolán na ministerstvo zahraničí.

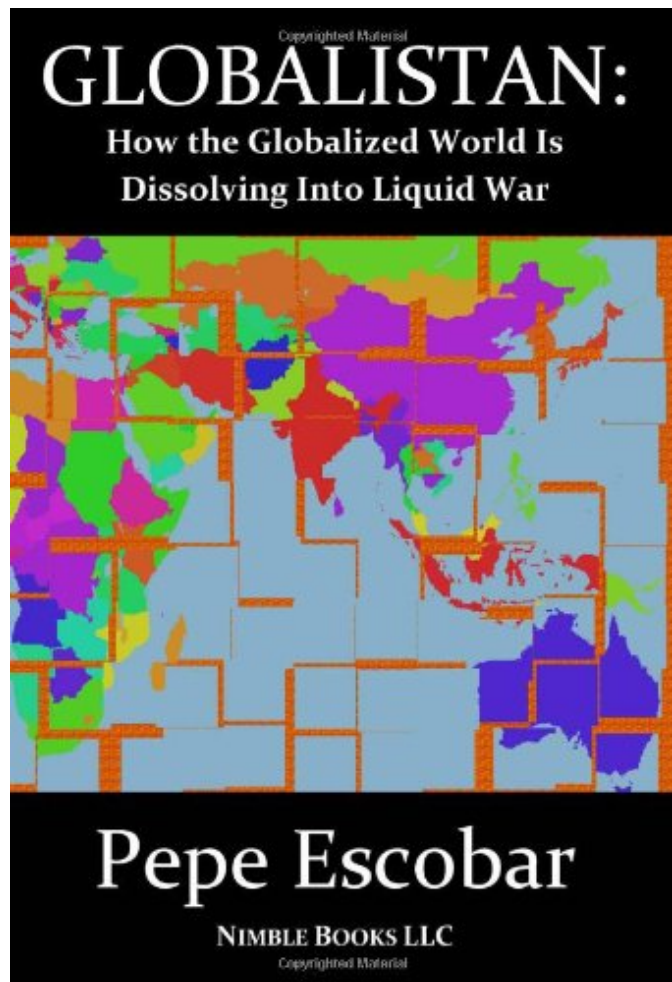

Wang Yi setkal s tajemníkem ruské bezpečnostní rady Nikolajem

Patruševem, než hovořil s Lavrovem a Putinem. Patrušev poznamenal,



že "kurz k rozvoji strategického partnerství s Čínou je absolutní prioritou ruské zahraniční politiky." Wang Yi, ne tak záhadně, dodal: "Moskva a Peking potřebují synchronizovat své hodinky."

Američané dělají vše, aby se pokusili předejít čínskému návrhu na deeskalaci na Ukrajině. Čínský plán by měl být předložen tento pátek a existuje vážné riziko, že se Peking dostane do pasti nastražené západní plutokracií.

As a result, Yanukovich was overthrown, and Putin blamed Poland, France, and Germany for not forcing Yanukovich's opponents to implement the agreement on a settlement of the political crisis in Ukraine signed on February 21, 2014, by the Ukrainian president and opposition leaders. "Was that the first time that the West deceived us," Russian journalist – critics would call him a propagandist – Vladimir Solovyov asked Putin. "It was possibly the first time that they deceived us in such a rude and arrogant way," the Russian leader replied. To this day, Putin continues blaming the West for violating various deals, quite aware that the Russian media will never dare to question the Kremlin's narrative. In other words, no mainstream figure on the Russian political scene will ever ask if Putin is a complete moron who keeps getting deceived by his Western partners or if he might consciously work for the interests of Russia's opponents.

MOSCOW — Every year, during the anniversary of the battle that turned back the Nazi assault on the Soviet Union, the city of Volgograd is briefly renamed Stalingrad, its Soviet-era name.

During this year’s commemoration, however, authorities went further. They unveiled a bust of the Soviet dictator Joseph Stalin, and paraded soldiers dressed as secret police in a bid to emphasize the parallels between Russia’s past and its present.

“It’s unbelievable but true: we are again being threatened by German Leopard tanks,” said Russian President Vladimir Putin, who traveled to Volgograd to deliver a speech on February 2. “Again and again, we have to repel the aggression of the collective West.”

Putin’s statement was full of factual inaccuracies: Russia is fighting not the West but Ukraine, because it invaded the country; the German Leopards being delivered to Kyiv date back only to the 1960s; there’s no plan for them to enter Russian territory.

But the Russian president’s evocation of former victories was telling — it was a distillation of his approach to justifying an invasion that hasn’t gone to plan. **These days in Russia, if the present is hard to explain, appeal to the past.**

It's an interesting read, but a bit misleading. It is like the Mithridates religion (simile), in which Mithridates and his assistants fight against an evil world, only now the evil world is the United States. How do we know the US is evil? The author tells us that. The piece is rhetoric, not reality.

Here's another story, without absolute evil but with human failings and with real-world implications:

The US after WW II tried to repress conflict, with some success. Korea, Vietnam, were both started by the other side; the US tried to stop the existing war. That more or less succeeded in Korea, and failed in Vietnam.

The US won the Cold War by suppressing local wars and by protecting trade between all nations in the US alliance. Its high point was the incorporation of the Asian Tigers and then China into the world trade system. However, free trade and shipping lanes deindustrialized the US, and in the long run (2008) failed [1]. US attempts to preserve world trade by extending the world trade system to the Middle East and North Africa region (MENA) failed badly, as did the US attempt to extend the world trade system to central Asia (Afghanistan war). The US never tried to introduce Sub-Saharan Africa as a major player in the world trade network, perhaps having learned from the failed European efforts to do likewise.

The US system of government was essentially destroyed by the above policies, which freed US government from control by the US electorate. Here's how that worked: Federal government charged a fee for the free trade and free sea lanes: US Dollar (USD) as reserve currency. This fee was collected by "inflating the USD", which amounted to borrowing money, and became much

higher as the US Federal Government found that it could seemingly borrow an almost unlimited amount of money from its free trade/sea lane participants. The professional politicians who ran the US Federal Government became, in effect, gnostics (this is a metaphor) who thought that their knowledge concerning world governance made them irreplaceable and above criticism. “Democracy” became a demonstration of power to win elections. By 2016, the gnostics asserted that “populism is the greatest threat to democracy”. By 2020, the Presidential elections had lost all connection with popular consent, and had become a demonstration of raw power, one that was continued into the mid-term elections. Domestic US politics became the archetypical struggle: the Jealous Gods who hated atheists (atheists are those who do not believe that the ‘elite’ Establishment is God) vs. the revolting public led by an almost superhuman symbol of atheism.

The Ukraine/Russian Federation conflict is a last ditch attempt to save the current free trade / free sea lane system, hence the US ability to borrow money, hence the entire US political system. The US goal is to forestall what had been a developing alliance between the Federal Republic of Germany (FRG) and the Russian Federation (RF), which would have eventually resulted in US ejection from its last major ally, the European Union (EU) in Eurasia. With adequate raw resources from RF, RFG would have no need to lend money to the US.

Unfortunately, the Ukraine/Russian Federation conflict is going badly for the US, and the US will have to (a) fall back on the AUKUS plus Japan alliance, and (b) develop a new political system.

The US actions since 1946 have been, on the whole, beneficial, at least in the short run. They have raised the “bottom billion” out of poverty, have industrialized Southeast Asia, and have enabled the

world population to reach 8 billion people without widespread starvation. US actions have achieved almost every goal the US claimed to have in WW II.

Unfortunately, the WW II goals have proven destructive in the long run. One of the more dismal MIT *Limits to Growth* [1] projections is being closely followed, the US has been de-industrialized (which you could view as a Christ like sacrifice), and government “of the people, by the people, and for the people” is considered an “insurrection” when Whites are part of the people. Insurrection or “mutiny” is suppressed by visibly stealing elections and by extra-legal arrest of “insurrectionists” later found guilty of simple trespassing.

All you can really say is that the US has destroyed itself, and will have to find completely different foundations. That the whole thing was evil is simply not true, and the idea that it was is simply an obstacle to finding or making some sort of foundation that isn't killing off its base population (ensuring below replacement rate fertility and forcing its population into “tent cities”). Start by thinking that the post-WW II dominance of the US has slipped out of US fingers (metaphor), that anything assuming post-WW II dominance is consequently failing, and will fail more severely when and if RF wins the RF/Ukraine war.

For example, Federal welfare funding will end with US inability to borrow without limit, and, with the welfare funding, so too will end the large cities and the State governments of those US States that are dominated by their cities. The rest of the US will merely be impoverished, but the impoverishment will be severe. What then, readers?

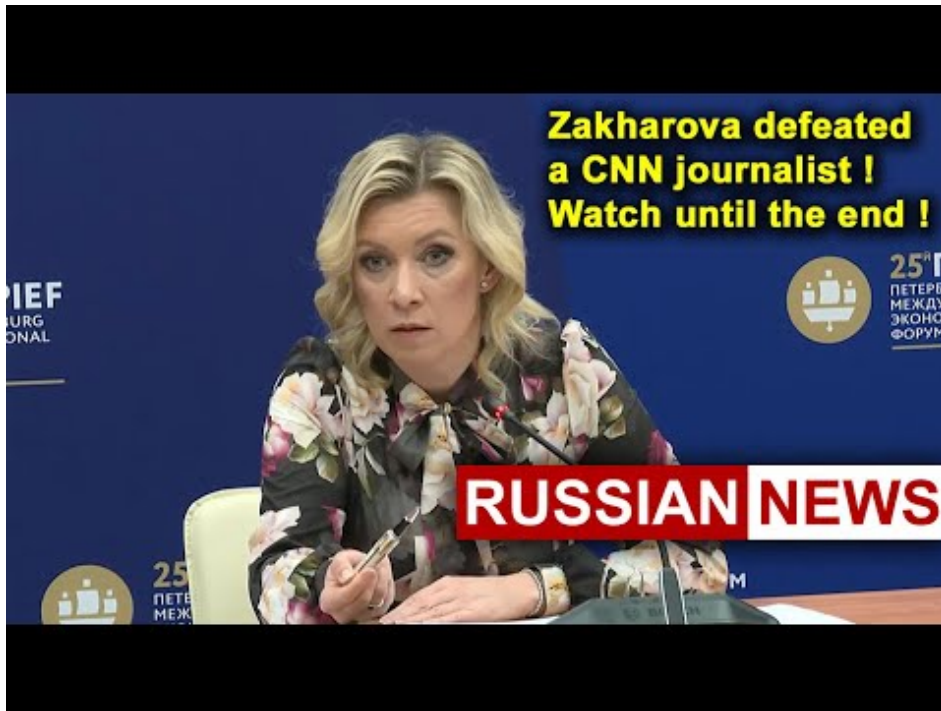

The West Is Avoiding the Big Question About Ukraine Until the U.S. and allies decide what victory looks like for Kyiv, Europe isn't likely to have peace.

Joe Biden's double bill in Kyiv and Warsaw this week is good political optics on the first anniversary of the worst war in Europe in 80 years.

Presumably not by anyone's design, this scenic coupling also usefully clarifies the stakes for the region and the hard choices before the U.S. and its allies in the coming months.

For nearly the entirety of the previous two centuries, Poland sat precisely where Ukraine does now — on the front line of Europe's defining clash between autocracy and liberalism, waged with the force of ideas and, as often, troops and armor. Poland was on the losing side most of that time. Its fate wasn't settled until it ended up in the so-called West and its elite clubs, NATO and the EU, some two decades ago. Ukraine faces a similar predicament: It's not clear where Ukraine fits, and the West hasn't decided how hard to fight for it.

In its time, the "Polish question" tore Europe apart. When the Poles started an uprising against Russia in 1830, after partitions had erased their country from the European map a generation before, Tsar Nicholas I laid out the choice: "Poland or Russia must now perish." Free Poland and authoritarian Russia couldn't coexist. Nicholas put down the Polish insurrection, consigning Russia — as the Russian writer Peter Chaadayev, who saw the uprising firsthand, wrote — to "her own enslavement, and the

enslavement of all neighboring peoples.” A century later, Hitler started World War II to enslave his eastern neighbors; after Yalta, Stalin got Poland and the region as his prize.

That's OK as *reactive* strategies go, but the resultant dislocation can ruin the standard of living of the median person. The better strategy is **proactive**.

One of the things that sapience enables is the ability to consider the 'not now' in both directions. In one direction it gives us nostalgia, tradition, and learned behaviour; in the other it gives us planning, foresight, and the (limited) ability to anticipate and mitigate some of life's vicissitudes. We can anticipate *consequences*; we can do it reasonably well if we put our minds to it.

The best way to mitigate the (necessary) periodic upheavals cause by the "reactive" strategy ("wait until the political class becomes intolerable, then execute them") is to pre-empt the upheaval by killing any person who exhibits political ambition. They're identifiable as teenagers, with very few exceptions, but teens can grow out of it – so perhaps the correct thing to do is use university politics as the way to 'paint the target' to reduce false positives.

I'm a dyed-in-the-wool consequentialist utilitarian about most things, but especially when it comes to the political class and its effects on society.

When it's all said and done, politics in the social body is like aggressive metastatic cancer in the human body – with the 'twist' that the cancer of politics can convince a very large part of its host that it's **ACK-SHULLY** good for the host.

Kill those who can't resist the urge to seek to dominate **before** they get into positions of power. It's like identifying and excising a cancer before it metastasises.

That strategy – when applied to cancer – sounds too much like 'screening', which is a stupid strategy unless the screening test has unrealistic attributes that are never achieved clinically.

There is a **critical** difference when used to eliminate political aspirants: after the first few executions almost **all** political aspirants will keep their heads down. The ones who won't be able to do that: definitely **not** a false positive.

To riff off the famous utterance of Papal legate Arnaud Amaury at the siege of Béziers in 1209:

| Caedite Eos: gaudet Diabolus habere eos.

Kill them all: the devil will be glad to have them (back).

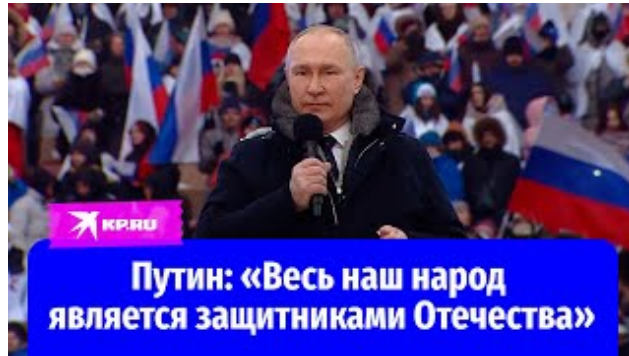
