- jak se válka promítá do vznikající aliance mezi Ruskem a Čínou, spolu s Brazílií, Indií, Íránem, arabskými zeměmi a pravděpodobně Afrikou – a co to bude znamenat pro dolar jako světovou rezervní měnu i pro prosperitu a moc USA;
- dělat to, co ostatní média považují za bílé nacionalistické řeči a o kterých se drtivá většina konzervativců nikdy nezmiňuje (velké nahrazení, imigrace rozmělňující bílé hlasy, touha demokratů mít stálou vládu levice importováním závislého, nízko- IQ, snadno ovladatelná nebílá populace, která vyžaduje vládní finanční pomoc a afirmativní akce, a snadno vidí výhody obviňování všech svých problémů z bílého rasismu, zatímco konzervativci hlavního proudu zdůrazňují utrpení a smrt migrantů, kteří se snaží dostat do USA; jeho sympatický rozhovor s maďarským nacionalistou Viktorem Orbánem);
- mluvit o vlivu George Sorose, zejména při volbě krajně levicových aktivistických žalobců, přestože ADL prosazuje myšlenku, že jakákoli zmínka o něm je antisemitská;

- odsuzuje Světové ekonomické fórum a globalismus obecně pravděpodobně související s jeho opozicí vůči ukrajinské válce;
- postavit se proti probuzené agendě ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance) korporátních gigantů, jako je Blackrock, schopných využít svaly akcionářů k tomu, aby přinutily společnosti, aby se přizpůsobily jejich preferencím politiky probuzení; Blackrock je hlavním investorem společnosti Fox;
- hněvat ADL a mocnosti obecně vším výše uvedeným; a často odsuzuje globalistické, proimigrační republikány jako Lindsey Graham a Mitch McConnell, kteří podporují stejné problémy;

 naznačuje, že bylo mnohem méně násilné, než jak je vyobrazeno,
 a že ministerstvo spravedlnosti Merricka Garlanda je zapálené
 pro nehorázné stíhání, porušování svobody projevu a
 občanských práv (zamykání občanů na dlouhou dobu bez soudu;
- odsuzovat cenzuru sociálních médií (jak je odhaleno v souborech na Twitteru) a pobuřující Garland DOJ, FBI atd.;
- přechod na transgenderismus (sterilizace dětí je civilizační sebevražda a "zlo") – a probuzení obecně
- mluvit o velké mediální zaujatosti ve volbách v roce 2020, včetně vyhledávání na Googlu a zákazu stínů na Twitteru.



Ukrajinská válka je globalistická křížová výprava

Tucker také prezentoval standardní konzervativní témata, jako je nelegální přistěhovalectví, zbraně, kriminalita ve městech, Bidenova korupce a senilita atd. Ale mám dojem, že byl na mnohé z výše uvedených problémů mezi osobnostmi Foxu sám, nebo své komentáře formuloval na ně podrážděnějším způsobem. A vůbec, jeho komentář byl mnohem pronikavější a intelektuálně přitažlivější. To vše děsilo globalistický, multikulturní establishment na celém Západě.

ADL byl <u>nadšený</u>, že Fox zrušil jeho show:

Pro Anti-Defamation League byla střelba dlouho opožděná. Vůdce skupiny <u>vyzval Foxe</u>, <u>aby Carlsona vyhodil v roce 2021</u> poté, co hostitel poprvé ve vysílání propagoval teorii Velkého nahrazení bílé rasy.

"Je na čase," napsal v pondělí na Twitteru generální ředitel skupiny Jonathan Greenblatt. "Příliš dlouho Tucker Carlson využíval svůj hlavní vysílací pořad k chrlení antisemitské, rasistické, xenofobní a anti-LGBTQ nenávisti na miliony."

V té době Fox <u>o několik týdnů později petici ADL odmítl</u>. Síť uvedla, že Carlson ve skutečnosti mluvil o volebních právech, když nastínil teorii Velkého nahrazení, krajně pravicové přesvědčení, které připisuje diverzifikaci voličů stínovému spiknutí, typicky vytvořenému Židy, aby nahradili bílé voliče imigranty a menšinovými skupinami. "Úplný přehled rozhovoru s hostem ukazuje, že pan Carlson odsuzoval a odmítl teorii náhrady," řekl tehdy Lachlan Murdoch, generální ředitel Fox Corporation.

Veřejný postoj ADL k Carlsonově zaměstnání vedl ke kritice zprava, přičemž floridský poslanec Matt Gaetz <u>nazval skupinu "rasistickou". Carlson na ně ve svém programu šel</u> také tím, že papouškoval další přesvědčení o Izraeli sousedící s bílou nadřazeností. Minulý rok poskytl rozšířený rozhovor Kanye Westovi poté, co si rapper na pařížském týdnu módy oblékl košili "White Lives Matter", ale ještě před mnoha Westovými veřejnými antisemitskými výkřiky; producenti údajně <u>vymazali antisemitské komentáře, které West</u>

Odkaz na "papouškování jiných přesvědčení o Izraeli sousedících s bílou nadřazeností" odkazuje na Tuckerovo zveřejnění postoje ADL k imigraci do Izraele v položce, která byla brzy smazána z jejich webových stránek.

učinil během rozhovoru.

ADL nedávno odsoudila Tuckera Carlsona, osobnost amerických médií, protože zmínil, že američtí voliči byli nahrazováni imigranty, a označila to za "hlavu bílé rasy, že bílá rasa je ohrožena rostoucím přílivem nebílých. Je to antisemitské, rasistické a toxické." V reakci na to Carlson zdůraznil různé postoje ADL ohledně demografického vysídlení původní evropské populace USA s jejich postoji k jednostátnímu řešení izraelsko-palestinského konfliktu.

Pokud jde o Izrael, ADL celkem rozumně prohlásila, že řešením jednoho státu je vzhledem k současné realitě a historickým nepřátelstvím neproveditelné. S historicky vysokou porodností mezi Palestinci a možným přílivem palestinských uprchlíků a jejich potomků, kteří nyní žijí po celém světě, by se Židé rychle stali menšinou v rámci dvounárodnostního státu, čímž by pravděpodobně skončilo jakékoli zdání rovného zastoupení a ochrany. V této situaci by židovská populace byla stále více politicky – a potenciálně fyzicky – zranitelná. Je nereálné a nepřijatelné očekávat, že Stát Izrael dobrovolně podkope svou vlastní suverénní existenci a nacionalistickou identitu a stane se zranitelnou menšinou na tom, co bylo kdysi jeho vlastním územím.

Pokud jde o prohlášení ADL, že znepokojení nad demografickými změnami v USA je "antisemitské, rasistické a toxické", vezmeme-li v úvahu dlouhou historii rasových konfliktů v Americe, nedávný vzestup rasově motivovaného násilí a současnou důležitost hnutí, jako je Critical Rasová teorie, která v podstatě patologizuje bílé Američany v médiích a vzdělávacím systému, je rozumné předpokládat, že bílá populace bude také stále zranitelnější, pokud se stane menšinou.

" Výchozí hypotéza nedokáže vysvětlit židovský vliv"

<u>Tento článek v New York Times</u> naznačuje Foxovy obavy ohledně jeho myšlenek, počínaje textem, ve kterém tvrdil, že "Bílí muži nebojují", což byla část jeho reakce na skupinu bílých mužů, kteří se spojili s antifa demonstrantem, který *Times* samozřejmě interpretovaly jako další náznak toho, že Tucker byl "bílý nadřazený".



Carlsonův text, který znepokojil vůdce Fox: "Není to tak, jak bílí muži bojují"


Ačkoli show pana Carlsona, "Tucker Carlson Tonight" byla jen malým faktorem v obleku Dominionu, jeho osobní texty přitahovaly velké zkoumání.

Text o boji se objevil na vrcholu škodlivého řetězce zpráv, které byly veřejně odhaleny před soudem a které byly samy o sobě šokující. V dopise jednomu ze svých producentů po útoku na Kapitol popisuje pan Carlson prezidenta, kterého prosazoval ve své show, jako "démonickou sílu" a "ničitele".

Opakovaným tématem jeho pořadu během šesti let, kdy běžel v hlavním vysílacím čase na Fox News, bylo vytlačování bílých Američanů barevnými lidmi. Pan Carlson často rámoval témata ve zprávách jako součást většího boje mezi "my" a "oni", přičemž imigranti a další marginalizované skupiny neustále a jistě berou od bílých to, co jim dlouho patřilo: politickou a kulturní moc ve Spojených státech.

Zaútočil na černošské aktivisty sociální spravedlnosti a vylíčil imigranty ze Střední Ameriky jako pohromou národa. V roce 2018 řekl, že přistěhovalci dělají zemi "špinavější". Po masové střelbě v El Pasu z rukou střelce, který ve svém manifestu citoval přesvědčení bílé nadřazenosti, pan Carlson ve svém pořadu prohlásil, že nadřazenost bělochů "není skutečným problémem" a přirovnal to ke konspirační teorii.

Bylo tedy dost důvodů se ho zbavit. Nedávno <u>Megyn Kelly</u> tvrdila, že Fox uvolňuje videa Tuckera, která by v mnoha zhlédnutích vyvolala negativní dojmy, aby byl tak toxický, že by nebyl zaměstnatelný. (Výše citovaný článek z NYTimes zjevně unikli lidé napojení na Fox.) Kelly také tvrdí, že o Carlsonově odchodu se ještě musí jednat a nemůže zahájit další show, protože má stále smlouvu. $Breitbart \underline{tvrdi}$, že mu Fox zabrání získat novou show, dokud nebudou volby v roce 2024 bezpečně ve zpětném zrcátku. Vypadá to, že se to zvrhlo v totální válku. Další věrohodnou věcí, kterou někteří zmiňují, je, že



zbavit se Carlsona a obecně přejít k nevýraznějšímu, tradičnějšímu typu konzervatismu, jako je ten Paul Ryan (který je ve správní radě Fox), by přilákalo velké inzerenty zpět do Fox's. sestava v hlavním vysílacím čase. Bojkoty iniciované levicí v posledních letech opustily jeho show s inzerenty přímého marketingu, jako je Mike Lindell, Pillow Guy . A jak bylo zmíněno výše, Tucker se důrazně postavil proti ESG agendě hlavních investorů Fox, jako je levicový aktivista Blackrock v čele s Larry Finkem.

Je tedy pravděpodobné, že rozhodnutí ovlivnilo několik faktorů. Co můžeme očekávat, pokud se Tucker reinkarnuje někde v mediálním vesmíru? Je docela možné, že bude ještě podrážděnější, pokud nebude svázán s korporátním gigantem, který se zajímá hlavně o zisk a touží zůstat v aktuálně povolených hranicích veřejné debaty. Jako někdo, kdo je důvěrně obeznámen s tím, jak funguje politika ve Washingtonu, si nepochybně uvědomuje židovský vliv, ale

spíše pochybuji, že řekne něco, co by naznačovalo, že Židé jsou jakýmkoli způsobem odpovědní za jakoukoli z otázek, které ho znepokojují. Často zmiňuje židovské padouchy jako Victoria Nuland, Alejandro Mayorkas, Merrick Garland nebo George Soros, aniž by řekl, že jsou Židé. A pravděpodobně bude i nadále zvát do své show Židy – Židy jako Michael Shellenberger o levicovém zničení San Francisca ,Darren Beattie z Revolver News na J6 nebo skeptik na očkování Alex Berenson. A pokud ho ADL znovu zavolá, jsem si jistý, že odpoví jako předtím.

Je zajímavé, že na rozdíl od mnoha konzervativců není otrocky proizraelský (jako např. Sean Hannity). Každý, kdo má ty nejmenší znalosti o tom, jak to ve Washingtonu chodí, chápe sílu izraelské lobby, ale tento problém prostě ignoruje. Nepamatuji si, že by dokonce diskutoval o Izraeli nebo izraelské lobby. *Haaretz* zmiňuje svůj "nedostatek nadšení pro židovský stát" – pravděpodobně další důvod, proč ho ADL nenávidí.

Tuckerův přístup k židovským otázkám není to, co by lidé na tomto webu chtěli, ale myslím, že probudil spoustu lidí a bude v tom pokračovat, pokud a až se znovu objeví. Proto má obrovské publikum. A je zcela pravděpodobné, že chápe židovskou angažovanost, ale věří (přiměřeně), že nemůže být dobrou strategií získat v brzké době politickou moc. To je pro spisovatele z *TOO* a podobně smýšlející místa, která hrají dlouhou hru – vydávají nápady, aby inteligentní pozorovatelé, kteří jsou nyní v hlavním proudu, pochopili, co se děje, i když nic neříkají veřejně.

Můj výchozí postoj je, že nejjednodušší vysvětlení je často to nejlepší. Zde prezentovaný názor nevyžaduje domněnku, že je ovládán Židy, dokud nebudou k dispozici lepší důkazy. Někdy Židé dělají chyby – myslím, že to udělali, když za ním šli na Velkém nahrazení, aniž by ze svých webových stránek alespoň smazali své obavy z nahrazení Židů v Izraeli. Židé nejsou vševědoucí.

Takže moje předpověď – za předpokladu, že nemá problém se smlouvou s Foxem – je, že se brzy znovu objeví, možná na NewsMax nebo OAN, a to poměrně brzy. A s tučnou smlouvou. Získá velké publikum a bude dělat to, co dělal dosud, jak je shrnuto v odrážkách výše. Měli bychom být šťastní. Půl chleba je mnohem lepší než žádný. Jeho komentáře po zrušení jsou optimistické:

Naše současné ortodoxie nevydrží. Jsou mozkově mrtví. Nikdo jim vlastně nevěří. Málokdo jimi zlepší život. Tento okamžik je příliš směšný, než aby mohl pokračovat, a tak nebude. Odpovědní lidé to vědí, proto jsou hysteričtí a agresivní. Oni se bojí. Vzdali se přesvědčování – uchylují se k síle. Ale to nepůjde. Když čestní lidé říkají, co je pravda, klidně a bez rozpaků, stávají se mocnými. Zároveň se lháři, kteří se je snažili umlčet, zmenšují – a stávají se slabšími. To je železný zákon vesmíru; skutečné věci vítězí." "Kde stále můžete najít Američany, kteří říkají pravdivé věci? Místa už moc nezbývá, ale nějaká jsou – a to stačí. Dokud slyšíte slova, je tu naděje. Brzy se uvidíme.


