Videozáznam zveřejněný RT Balkan zachytil okamžik, kdy se protest Srbů v severním Kosovu proměnil v potyčku mezi demonstranty a kosovskými silami NATO (KFOR).

Demonstranti se v pondělí ráno postavili proti vojákům KFOR před obecními budovami ve městě Zvecan, kde se měl po volbách bojkotovaných srbskou většinou ujmout úřadu nově dosazený starosta etnických Albánců.

Video ukazuje dvě skupiny demonstrantů, kteří pokojně sedí poblíž vojáků, jedna bezprostředně před kamerou a druhá dále. Směrem k poslední jmenované skupině se ozve hlasitý výbuch, po kterém následují podobné rány. Síly NATO vrhají slzný plyn do davu, který reaguje házením kamenů na vojáky.

Reportér RT Balkan na místě uvedl, že KFOR vyprovokoval střety vypálením prvního omračujícího granátu, ale ze snímků to není hned patrné.

Asi 50 demonstrantů bylo hospitalizováno se zraněními v nedaleké Mitrovici a dva byli přijati na pohotovost, uvedla RT Balkan. 25 vojáků KFOR bylo zraněno při boji zblízka, oznámily síly v prohlášení.

Napětí v severním Kosovu zůstává vysoké od dubna, kdy srbská většina v regionu bojkotovala volby podporované administrativou etnických Albánců v Prištině.

Kosovské úřady považovaly výsledky voleb – v nichž zvítězili čtyři starostové etnických Albánců v nesporných závodech – za legitimní, a to i přes účast nižší než 4 %.

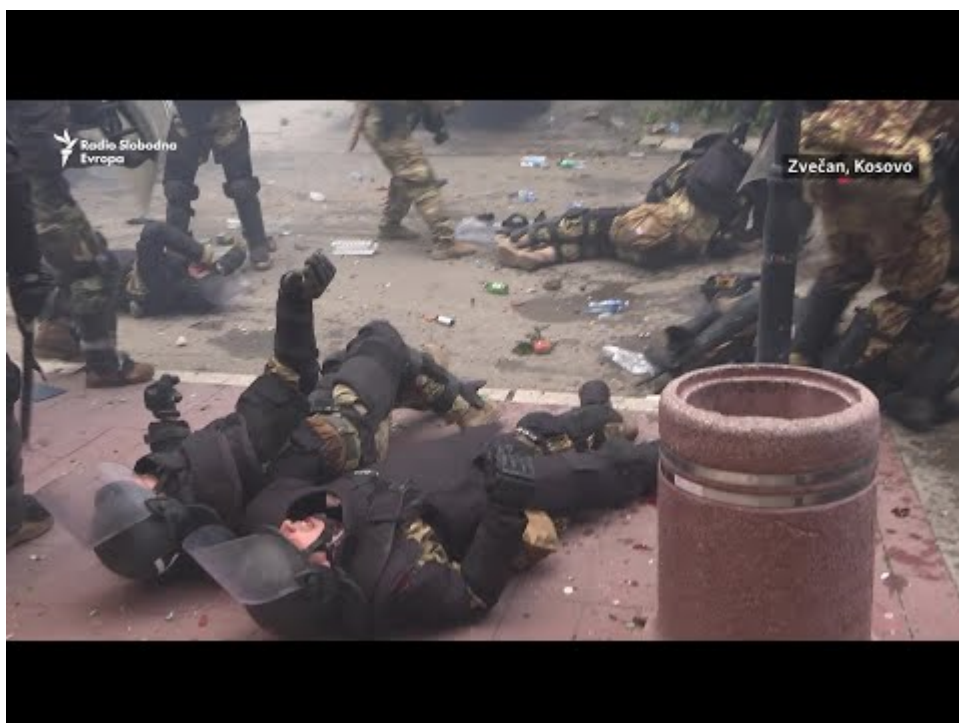

Feels strange how often on this website comments just go off on random tangents that aren't even about the topic itself.

But to keep it as simple as possible.

1: Shiptars imposed Albanian mayors on Serb municipalities of North Kosovo (Zvecan, Leposavic, Zubin Potok – different story with North Mitrovica since ROSU forced open barrier blocking bridge on South Mitrovica with passive NATO approval). They made fake elections that Serbs boycotted with less than 3.5% of votes out of around 50,000 Serbs in North KiM. Think it was literally less than 15 Serbs that voted (some NGO traitors, others old people that didn't watch latest news). Rest were Albanian population, but ironically it seems they voted less than in other elections.

2: Since the Albanian elections, imposition of mayors and usurpation of Serb autonomies/rights is obviously illegitimate, Shqips have moved in with “special police forces”/ROSU to enforce the entry of their mayors into municipality buildings in the North.

3: Back on 27th May Serbs clashed with Albanian forces first as they tried to block Abanians from occupying mayor building in Zvecan. They literally beat a Serb woman on the street while using tear gas. Regardless, NATO or “KFOR” troops then intervened on 29th May to ensure Shqips take over municipality buildings and block local Serbs from quartering the Albanians. This then means that NATO troops are taking over for Shqips in fighting the Serbs and ensuring “Kosovo” occupation of the

North. The clash of NATO troops against the local Serbs got much messier than expected. Serbs initially protested peacefully, but then NATO troops started beating Serbs with hostility. Although more than 50 Serbs have been wounded with tear gas and beatings, and everything associated, Serbs actually managed to wound more than around 41 NATO soldiers. Like beating with large wooden sticks – that viral video footage of the bald and bearded Serb beating against NATO troops with riot shields as he snatched a baton from one of them somehow. NATO troops also tried to kidnap one of the demonstrating Serbs, but the rest of the Serbs intervened in a pile to rescue one of our fellows. 4: Vucic then partly mobilized Serbian Army and has sent Serb military and special forces units on to the “border” with Kosovo. Deployments of these forces obviously aren't advertised to

media.

5: Currently all sorts of diplomacy and negotiating schemes and processes are going on behind the scenes. Vucic met with the ambassadors of the Quint countries – USA and Western Europe (Britain, France, Germany, and Italy). Vucic also met Russian and Chinese ambassadors. Vucic is now negotiating at “Europe summit” in Moldova alongside most other NATO-EU and world leaders. Even Zelensky and Modi of India too.

6: It’s hard to tell, but it actually seems that this is all a case of the “tail wagging the dog” as Srdja Trifkovic describes it. That is, Shiptars are trying to strike now and ethnically cleanse Kosovo of Serbs while they still have what they see as an opportunity amid the uncertainty over Ukraine. What seems strange is that US ambassador to “Kosovo” Jeff Hoveneir stated in an interview that USA was dropping support for Kosovo, including international recognition campaign, funding of programs, and they even cancelled Kosovo participation in “Defender Europe 2023” NATO military exercise.
