Lord Rothschild discusses cousin's crucial role in 'miracle' Balfour Declaration

Současný a čtvrtý lord Rothschild popsal Balfourovu deklaraci, která pomohla připravit cestu ke vzniku Izraele, jako "zázrak" a odhalila nové podrobnosti o klíčové roli jeho sestřenice Dorothey.

Když mluvíme před stým výročím dopisu o 67 slovech, jsou to jeho vůbec první veřejné komentáře k projevu podpory tehdejšího zahraničního tajemníka Lorda Balfoura druhému lordu Rothschildovi, jeho excentrickému strýci Walterovi, a byly učiněny ve vzácném televizním rozhovoru s bývalým Izraelský velvyslanec Daniel Taub v rámci projektu Balfour 100.

Jacob Rothschild, 80, hlava rodinné bankovní dynastie, řekl, že prohlášení o podpoře židovské vlasti v Palestině prošlo pěti návrhy, než bylo nakonec sepsáno 2. listopadu 1917, a dodal: "Byla to největší událost v židovském životě pro tisíce lidí. let, zázrak... Trvalo 3000 let, než jsme se k tomu dostali."

Způsob, jakým toho bylo dosaženo, byl podle něj mimořádný. "Byl to nejneuvěřitelnější kus oportunismu. Měli jste zbídačeného rádoby vědce Chaima Weizmanna, který se nějakým způsobem dostane do Anglie, potká pár lidí, včetně členů mé rodiny, svede je, má takové kouzlo a přesvědčení, dostane se k Balfourovi a neuvěřitelně, přesvědčí Lorda Balfour a Lloyd George, předseda vlády, a většina ministrů, že tato myšlenka národního domova pro Židy by měla být povolena. Chci říct, že je to tak, tak nepravděpodobné."

Dopis "změnil běh dějin Blízkého východu a židovského národa," řekl Taub, který dělal rozhovor s Rothschildem na Waddeston Manor v Buckinghamshire, venkovské hromadě, kterou rodina odkázala národu v roce 1957, kde je Deklarace uložena.

Bylo to napsáno Walteru Rothschildovi, přírodovědci a sběrateli, který se v první řadě zajímal o ornitologii (studium ptáků), řekl Jacob, a "hluboce výstřední muž, který jezdil po parku Tring na obřích želvách a jehož kočár byl tažen zebry.

Walter se o sionismus začal zajímat až v pozdějším životě, ale Rothschild řekl, že byl "hluboce oddán Izraeli od 60. let a od té doby je tam každý rok".

Řekl však, že jeho rodina byla v té době rozdělena na myšlenku Izraele a poznamenal, že někteří členové "nemysleli, že by bylo dobré, aby tam byl zřízen tento národní domov".

Poprvé také odhalil roli své sestřenice Dorothy de Rothschild, která působila jako kritický prostředník, když byla ještě v pubertě. Rothschild ji popsal jako "oddanou Izraeli" a řekl: "To, co udělala, což bylo velmi důležité, bylo spojit Weizmanna s britským establishmentem, a mimořádně Weizmannovi řekla, jak se integrovat, jak se začlenit do života britského establishmentu, což se naučil velmi rychle."

Její dopisy, které jsou uloženy ve Waddestonu, podrobně popisují její pozdější jednání s řadou sionistických vůdců a její rady ohledně organizace sionistické konference a Rothschild řekl, že na něj měla

hluboký vliv, představila mu Izrael a rodinnou filantropickou založení v roce 1962.

Students "shocked" after Holocaust denial leaflets are found at British campuses including UCL and Cambridge University.



Students have expressed shock at "deeply concerning" Holocaust denial leaflets that have appeared at British university campuses.

Literature denying and belittling the Nazi genocide has been found at University College

London, <u>Cambridge</u> University, <u>Edinburgh</u> University and <u>Glasgow</u> University, according to the Union of Jewish Students (UJS).

The leaflets deny the existence of gas chambers. One, entitled 'Who's telling us our story?', cites the film 'Denial', which dramatises the trial from 2000 in which Holocaust denier David Irving took historian Deborah Lipstadt to court for libel.

Who's telling us our story? A Hollywood film, just released in UK cinemas, would have us believe that a court case in 2000 proved the official version of the Holocaust. One of the litigants of that trial, British historian David Irving, had author and historian, Michael Hoffman, recently made the following observation about the new film: "I think that it's interesting to note that history is so often tried by Hollywood. They...create these puppet flagures, these simulacrums, these strawmen of David Irving in the movie, and then attack that and present that as the reality. And I think that it's an indicator of their insecurity and weakness, that they have to do this second hand through Tinsel Town rather than directly through a debate with bona-fide revisionist historians." The poster says: "A Hollywood film, just released in UK cinemas, would have us believe that a court case in 2000 proved the official version of the Holocaust. One of the litigants of that trial, British historian David Irving, had claimed that key elements of the official version are demonstrably false and want revision."

Another leaflet was found at Glasgow University, which entitled 'The greatest swindle of all time.' It quotes anti-Zionist professor Norman Finkelstein, author of 'the Holocaust Industry', whose parents both survived the Shoah. It refers to his work, before stating: "For the facts, gentlemen, not the Hollywood production..." and is followed by a website address and the hashtag #Holohoax.

UJS said: "The safety of Jewish students remains our highest priority; these incidents are deeply concerning and we continue to work closely with the CST (Community Security Trust) and the respective Jewish Societies to ensure the welfare and safety of all Jewish students.)

According to UJS, there have been variants of similar literature, some of which have been distributed "quite widely".

Karen Pollock, Chief Executive of the Holocaust Educational Trust, said: "That in 2017, anyone would deliberately deny, denigrate or belittle the historical facts of the Holocaust, particularly on a university campus, is absolutely disgusting. This literature is highly offensive and the intent is clear – to belittle and undermine the tragic murder of 6 million people, just because they were Jews – antisemitism pure and simple. I hope the Universities in question realise how serious this is and find out who is behind this as an urgent priority."

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Benjamin Netanyahu with Mahmoud Abbas

Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas has said Israeli legislation to retroactively legalise thousands of West Bank settlement homes is an aggression against the Palestinian people.

"That bill is contrary to international law," Mr Abbas said following a meeting with French President Francois Hollande in Paris.

"This is an aggression against our people that we will be opposing in international organisations."

"What we want is peace ... but what Israel does is to work towards one state based on apartheid," Mr Abbas said.

Mr Hollande called on the Israeli government to go back on the bill approved by politicians late on Monday, saying it would "pave the way for an annexation, de facto, of the occupied territories, which would be contrary to the two-state solution".

Hours before Mr Abbas's meeting with Mr Hollande, Saeb Erekat, secretary general of the Palestinian Liberation Organisation, said the bill is "putting the last nail in the coffin of the two-state solution".

The measure is the latest in a series of pro-settler steps taken by Israel's hard-line government since the election of Donald Trump as US president.

Calling the move "theft", Mr Erekat said it was "the Israeli government trying to legalise looting Palestinian land".

In his joint statement with Mr Hollande, Mr Abbas also warned against moving the US embassy in Israel from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem, one of Mr Trump's campaign promises.

"Any move in that direction is an error and shouldn't be done prior to an agreement on a political solution", he said.

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
